WHO VISITS THE PTA CLOTHING BANK?

Students from any Albuquerque Public School (APS) that are referred by their teacher, nurse, counselor or principal needing clothes to attend school. Parent may contact the PTA Clothing Bank at their child's school. During the school year of 2009-2010 the PTA Clothing Bank clothed more than 2,500 APS students.

WHEN DO THEY VISIT THE PTA CLOTHING BANK?

Visits may occur during the school year, once in the Fall Semester and once in the Spring Semester. The current hours for the PTA Clothing Bank are 9am to 12:15pm, Tuesday through Friday for students and Monday to Friday from 9am to 1pm for accepting donations.

WHERE IS THE PTA CLOTHING BANK LOCATED?

The PTA Clothing Bank is located at 1730 University Blvd. SE.
(just south of the UNM Football Stadium)

WHAT DO STUDENTS RECEIVE FROM THE PTA CLOTHING BANK?

Each student receives **new** underwear, socks and shoes (as needed). They receive a minimum of two complete outfits (uniforms if necessary) to attend school. Depending on the need and season they will receive a light jacket or coat. The students are also given the opportunity to take up to 4 books as well as a toy and stuffed animal

HOW HAS THE PTA CLOTHING KEPT THEIR DOORS OPEN FOR MORE THAN 50 YEARS?

We depend on **both** financial and in-kind donations, including grants from a variety of sources. The Parent Organizations throughout Albuquerque Public Schools are very supportive by giving us yearly donations. We accept **GENTLY** used children's clothing sizes 5 to adult, **new** underwear, socks and shoes. Toys, books and stuffed animals new and gently used are also appreciated.
