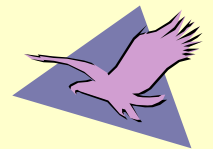

UPDATE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

New Mexico requires an updated inoculation for Kindergarten - 5th grade. The updated recommendation for the Varicella vaccine is as follows:

The first required dose should be administered at age 12-15 months and a newly recommended second dose should be administered at age 4-6 years.

HELPING A CHILD VENT ANGER

Many of us have been taught that anger is bad and that an angry person necessarily alienates and offends others. Certainly violent aggressive expression of anger is dangerous; to feel angry, however, is not evil, it is a normal feeling, a normal reaction to a stimulus.

Not honestly expressing anger leads to indirect behaviors that are not particularly healthy. Here are a few suggestions to help your child express his/her angry feelings in a constructive way:

Encourage your child to vent anger physically by running around outdoors, kneading a big

patch of play dough, spinning around and around, coloring or finger painting.

Teach the child to count to five in a **LOUD, ANGRY** voice, to play an **ANGRY** song on a musical instrument (pots and pans are fine), or to dance an **ANGRY** dance.

Shout something loud with your child and let your voices drop...drop...until there’s silence.

Ask an angry child to draw a picture showing how he or she feels, a creative way to relieve feelings. *From Fonda Kirchmeyer—Our DE School Counselor*
