NEWS FROM THE NURSE

Hello GOK Families! This Fall we will have a flu mist only clinic October 20, 2011. The Flu vaccine clinic is FREE. Information regarding the vaccine and permission slips will be coming home in your child's backpack. Flu mist will only be given to students whose parents have signed and returned the permission slip. This will be a flu mist only clinic, if your child has asthma, diabetes, seizure disorder, or any weakened immune system they cannot receive the flu mist. Any questions or concerns please call the health office 293-4259 and press 2 for the nurse.

Flu season is near, along with getting the flu vaccine, having your child wash their hands frequently, getting adequate sleep and nutrition will help keep children healthy. Please remember that children need to stay home when they have a fever of 100 or higher, vomiting or diarrhea. It is APS policy that students must be fever-free (without fever-reducing medication) for 24 hours before returning to school. If your child is on antibiotics for a contagious bacterial infection, such as strep throat, they must be on the antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school.

1. Go to www.innisbrook.com

4. Verify that the school name is correct and click "Continue to EZ".
5. "Set up Username & Password" window will pop up. Fill out form & click continue.
6. Click on student's teacher name & click continue (You can only add one teacher here. After registering your student you will be given the opportunity to add another student & teacher).
7. Register student information & click continue. Write down student ID number.
8. Click on "Enter Orders From My Order Worksheet" & continue.
9. Click on student name & continue.
10. Enter orders from your order worksheet & submit (You can always go back and enter orders at any time).
11. A confirmation email will be sent to you with your username, password and student's ID number.

3. The jumpers selected will than practice with AAJR for approximately one month (maybe more). If the jumper can become a Level One in that time frame, they can become part of AAJR.

Please practice your Level One Tricks and do not forget to practice your speed too.
