

WEST MESA CLUSTER SCHOOL STANDARD DRESS GUIDE

This uniform dress policy will apply:

To all students in these schools

Except where there are specific instructional, safety religious, or medical reasons

General Requirements:

No gang- related clothing

No chains or spiked jewelry

No sunglasses, hairnets, hats* or bandanas

No clothing or accessories which promote negative behaviors (profanity, violence, sex, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, bigotry, disrespect, or gangs) or that is highly distracting, disruptive, or immodest

Hats may be worn on elementary playgrounds-not inside buildings

Pants (Boys and Girls):

Solid colors: black, khaki (tan), navy blue

Straight-legged, regular cut

Pleated or plain front

Fitted at the waist

Worn with a black, brown or navy belt, no excess length hanging down (grade 3 & up)

Students grade 2 and under may wear pants with an elastic waistband

Neither baggy nor tight

No extra wide legs

No dropped crotch

No saggy pants

No denim (jeans)

No sweat or jogging pants

No overalls

Shorts (Boys and Girls):

Same guidelines as pants, and

No longer than the knee

No shorter than two inches above knee

No short overalls

Skirts or Jumpers

(Girls):

Solid colors: black, navy blue, or

Khaki (tan)

Pleated or straight skirt, or skort

No shorter than two inches above knee

Shirts/Blouses (Boys and Girls):

Solid colors: burgundy, light blue, navy green (forest), white, and red

Worn tucked into pants, shorts, or skirt

Collared with button, or

Turtleneck (mock or regular)

Short or long sleeves, not sleeveless

No transparent or sheer materials

No logos, designs or trimmed collars

No tank tops or bare midriffs

Sweatshirts/ Sweaters/Vest

(Boys and Girls):

Solid colors: burgundy, light blue, navy blue, or white

Worn over a legal shirt
Do not wear tucked into pants

No hoods

No logos

Jackets (Boys & Girls):

No professional team jackets except for NM professional & NM college teams
