

Lavaland School Rules

1. No fighting. Lavaland has a Zero Tolerance Policy towards fighting. If a child is involved in a fight while under the supervision of the school, parent/s or guardian/s will be notified and asked to pick up the student immediately. Consequences will be given as outlined by the APS Behavioral Handbook. When the student returns to school, she/he will be referred to the counselor and the parents will be expected to meet with the principal or principal designee.
2. Respect will be shown for all people and property. Vandalism will not be tolerated.
3. Students will remain on campus and within the authorized playground area during school hours except when accompanied by an authorized adult.
4. Unacceptable behavior which disrupts the learning of others will not be tolerated.

Playground Rules

All playground equipment and grounds will be used in a safe manner.

BALLS

Only balls or other appropriate playground equipment may be thrown or kicked. Dirt, grass, rocks, snowballs, etc. may not be thrown or kicked.

SWINGS

Swings should be occupied by one child at a time.

Children should sit, not stand or tummy sit while swinging.

Children should stay a safe distance from swings and not stand behind or in between swings.

Children should not jump off swings but wait for swing to come to a completed stop before getting off or on.

Children should swing straight, not sideways.

Children should not push one another on the swings.

Children should hold on with both hands.

Children should not twist the chains or wind the seats.

JUNGLE GYM- MONKEY BARS

This apparatus should be used for climbing and crossing hand over hand.

No one may chicken fight or jump from bars.

SOFTBALL (BACKSTOPS) AND BASKETBALL COURTS

No one should climb the posts, stand on or hang from basketball rims or net. Children should not climb on the backstops.

TETHER BALL

Children should not sit or hang on the tether ball. Toss and hit ball only.

PLAYGROUND

Roughhouse physical contact or horseplay is not allowed (karate, tackle, piggyback rides, wrestling, boxing etc. are not allowed!)

THE STUDENT MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY THAT IS DANGEROUS OR THREATENS THE SAFETY OF THEMSELVES OR OTHERS.
