Synergy Online Registration:

Planning for the 2019-2020 school year version of Online Registration (OLR) is in progress! SIS will be providing regular updates regarding the timeline for rollout and training of online registration for the next school year in upcoming Tuesday Times, so please be on the lookout for these updates. - Online Registration for the 2019-2020 school year will be open **for all remaining schools on March 4, 2019.**

High School 4th - 6 week grades are due

Thursday, February 21, 2019

4th – 6 week grading window closes for teachers. Please ensure all teachers have entered their grades prior to leaving on this day. Any grade changes or entry after this deadline will be done in the main office with teachers and Curriculum Assistants.

120 Day State Reporting Pull Date – February 13, 2019:

Pull Date is Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 5pm. Please continue to run your data quality reports every day to ensure all are clean until the pull at 5pm. **This includes having licensed and active staff attached to all sections. Staff on a Leave of Absence in Lawson cannot be attached to sections on the pull date. Please plan ahead on who to attach if you have this error during training.**

Attention: School staff that enroll students

When enrolling a previously inactivated student into your school, please ensure you are placing them in the correct grade level on the Student Add screen **PRIOR** to saving. Synergy is currently experiencing previously enrolled grade level carrying over into newly enrolled school.

This creates issues when crossing school types in the following areas (*see example below*)

- Middle school 8th grade student being enrolled as a 1st grade student (based on last inactive enrollment)
- Once that 1st grader is scheduled in 8th grade classes, all teachers attached to that student is experiencing their gradebook report card type reverting to an Elementary “SBPR”
- All students assigned to those teachers cannot view their gradebook grades in StudentVUE

We have reported to Edupoint and will update once fixed. In the meantime, please double check those grade levels PRIOR to saving on Student Add Screen to avoid issues. SIS will keep up update upon resolve.

CTE Programs of Study:

All high school students taking CTE courses have been evaluated based on their course history to determine their program of study. The Student CTE screen has now been populated based on the program that had the most course history entered. Students identified with at least:

- 1 full credit of an Introduction CTE Course are labeled “Participator” along with the Program of Study to report.
- 2 full credits of a Concentrator CTE Course are labeled “Concentrator” along with their Program of Study to report.



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- 1 full credit of a Completer CTE Course are labeled “Completer” along with their Program of Study to report.

Test Security Spring 2019 Training **Now Available in Canvas

The 2018-19 Spring Test Security Training is now available online in Canvas.

All three Test Security courses are available in Canvas beginning **February 11, 2019**. Principals, School Test Coordinators and all school staff, who come in contact with testing materials, are required to complete the Spring 2019 training by March 29, 2019.

Each employee takes one of the following courses:

Test Security – School Test Coordinators – Spring 2019	For School Test Coordinators (STCs) and Principals
Test Security – Test Administrators – Spring 2019	For all test administrators including: Teachers, Librarians, Counselors, and Interventionists.
Test Security – Staff – Spring 2019	For EAs, proctors, security employees who unlock rooms and/or come in contact with testing materials.

- School Test Coordinators (STCs) ONLY need to complete one Fall course **Test Security – School Test Coordinators**, which is the highest level of Test Security.

How to take Test Security Training in Canvas:

1. 1.Go to: my.aps.edu and login
 NOTE: Your **username** is your employee ID (Example: e123456)
2. 2.Click the [Canvas](#) icon
3. 3.Click on the Test Security course on your canvas dashboard. If you do not have course, you can follow the instructions on how to self-enroll (**see attached**)
4. 4.Upon passing the Test Security Quiz, employees can print their grades using the [Grades](#) tab

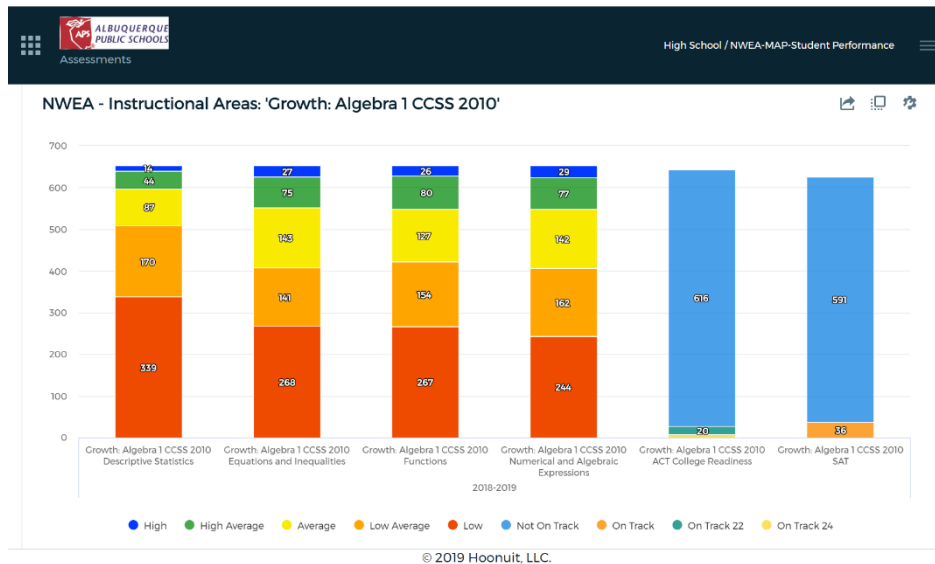

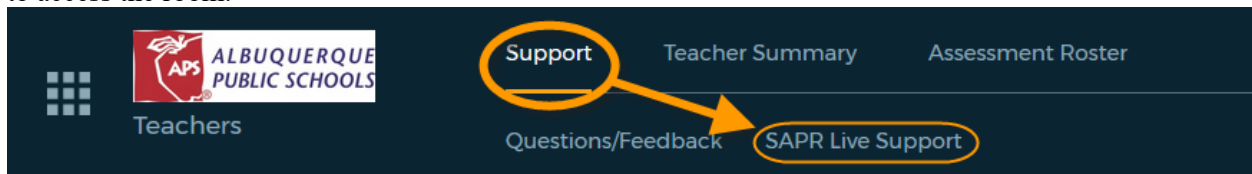


What Do My Enrollments Look Like for 2019-2020? The Feeds-To and Placement Reports Can Help Answer That Question

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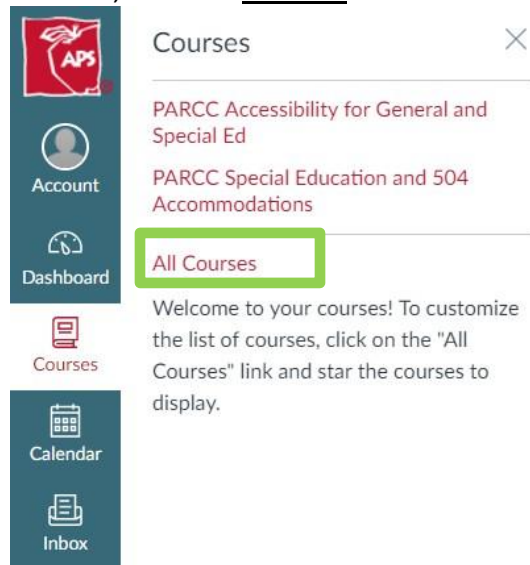

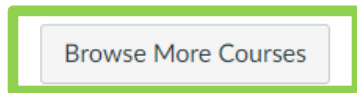

How to Self-enroll or “+Join” the Test Security Canvas Course

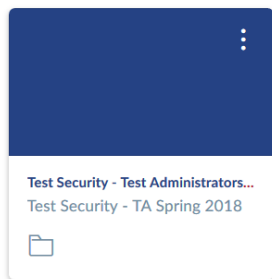
1. Go to: my.aps.edu and login
NOTE: Your **username** is your employee ID (Example: e123456)
2. Click the [Canvas](#) icon
3. On the left side, click the **Courses** icon  and select **All Courses**



4. Click **Browse More Courses** (On the right side of the screen)



5. Locate the level of course you require (STC, TA, or Staff) For example: **Test Security – Test Administrators – Spring 2019** course box and click on the **+Join this Course** to enroll. NOTE: New courses will show up on the second page of browsing for a course. Remember to choose next to locate the course.



6. Upon passing the Test Security Quiz, employees can print their grades using the [Grades](#) tab (*Certificate of Completion is not available in Canvas*).
