Postponement and/or cancellation of the event due to an emergency, inclement weather and/or facility/playing conditions will be in accordance with NFHS, NMAA and APS guidelines. An adjustment of the tournament schedule or the cancellation of the event will be determined and announced by the APS Athletic Department.

Bracket Information Brackets will be a 64-player draw with the top 8 seeds identified. The tournament will consist of four single elimination brackets: boys singles, girls singles, boys doubles and girls doubles. Third place matches will be played in the championship round.

Event Information USTA regulations will govern rules of play inclusive of court conduct. For the purpose of interpretation of USTA regulations, the tournament director will serve in the capacity of the referee. When deemed necessary, the tournament director may appoint a neutral coach to serve as a chair umpire.

Changes in the draw must be reported to the tournament director in accordance with USTA regulations. Players are to check in with the tournament director fifteen minutes prior to scheduled match time.

A member of the coaching staff must be in attendance whenever any of their players are competing. Coaching during play is permitted. Members of the coaching staff are the only individuals authorized to communicate with and/or coach his/her player(s) during a match. Communication may only occur through the fence during change of sides. In the case of split sets, a 10-minute break may be awarded at the request of either player and coaching may occur during this time.

Event Information

Match balls will be provided by the tournament director and are to be returned upon completion of each match. Warmup balls are the responsibility of the player/team.

Match scoring will be two out of three sets with a 7-point set tiebreaker. A 10-point match tiebreak will be played in lieu of a third set in rounds one and two.

Team scoring will be 1 point for each advancement; winners of second round matches who had a first round bye will be awarded 2 points. A half point will be awarded for third place match wins.

Team championship ties are resolved in the following order:

1. The team with the highest percentage of sets won versus total sets actually played/completed by all team members shall be declared the team champion.
2. The team with the lowest percentage of games lost versus games actually played/completed by all team members shall be declared the team champion.

The event director will coordinate event site responsibilities with the tournament directors and other appropriate event personnel.

Awards

Albuquerque Metro Championship apparel, individual championship medals and team championship trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the tournament.
