Event Information

Tournament bracket matches will be posted on the APS Athletic Department website with the home team listed first. For pool play, the home team is the first team listed for each match; refer to pool play schedule. For bracket play, the team listed on the top of the bracket is the home team.

The home team will provide a libero tracker and a game ball(s). Each team will provide a line judge. Scorebooks will be provided by the APS Athletic Department for pool play and bracket play.

Pool play matches will be 2 games to 25 points starting at a score of 4-4 with a cap of 27 points. Warm-up sessions will begin immediately following the conclusion of the previous match. Refer to pool play schedule.

Pool Play Schedule

First warm-up session will begin at 3:45pm at all sites; first match will begin at 4:00pm. Matches 1 and 2 will be scheduled with a 15 minute warm-up session; all other matches will be scheduled with a 9 minute warm-up session, 3-3-3 format.

Placement in brackets will be determined by pool play results. The following tiebreaking procedures will be applied:

1. Head to head competition
2. Point differential among tied teams
3. Point differential among all teams in pool
4. Coin toss

Any time throughout tiebreaking procedures, when a multiple (3 or more) team tie is reduced to two teams, head-to-head competition will be used to determine higher placement.

The event director will coordinate host site responsibilities with the school athletic director and other appropriate event personnel.

Results Pool Play: The host site athletic directors shall report match results to the event director upon conclusion of pool play. Bracket Play: The event director will be responsible for confirming match results with score table personnel.

Awards The championship trophy will be presented at the conclusion of the championship game in the Gold Bracket.
