The life, health & safety of students is paramount in the operations of Albuquerque Public Schools (APS). Over 40,000 students are transported to and from school and for educational activities on 450 buses every (school) day in the APS school district. This makes APS the largest mass transit operator in the state of NM. The safe operation and upkeep of student transit equipment as well as the training/housing of student transit personnel makes it necessary to construct and maintain adequate transportation facilities.

Project Description: Remodel of 2-story office building and bus maintenance garage/warehouse. Scope includes the following ADA (restrooms & elevator) upgrades: new restroom facilities, elevator, exterior ramps, and compliant handrails. Open & private offices and ancillary spaces for transportation personnel. Includes upgrades/equipping of bus maintenance garage as well as construction of parking area for buses and cars. This facility will be the main student transportation hub for the APS district.

Project Scope: 33,423 sq. ft.

- ADA Upgrades to Restrooms, Elevator, Exterior Ramps and Handrails.
- Renovate Open Offices and Private Offices
- Renovate & Equip bus maintenance garage
- Construct Parking for 350 buses, and 400 APS vehicles
- Repair and Maintenance shops for District School Bus Fleet
- Fueling Facilities
