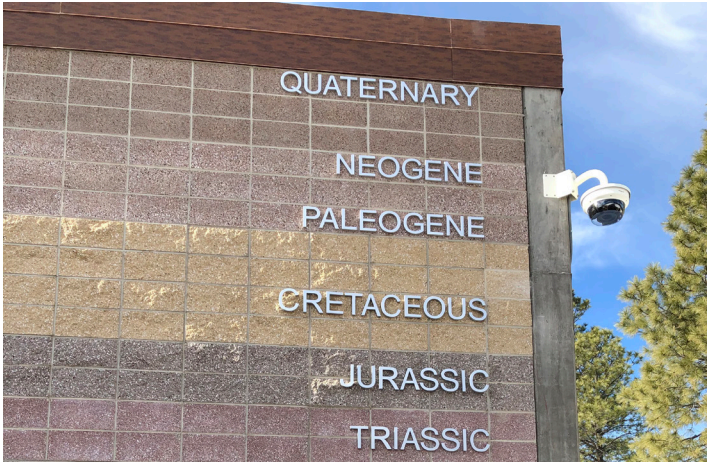




Sandia Mountain Natural History Center Fact Sheet

Project Description: The Sandia Mountain Natural History Center (SMNHC) is an environmental education center that serves all APS 5th graders. The design & construction of these new facilities includes: administrative offices, museum space, five general classrooms, one classroom equipped as a science lab, staff workshop, restrooms, parking lot, and outdoor activity spaces. The project also includes a solar Photo Voltaic (PV) electrical system and a solar hydronic heating system, which together allow the facility to have no electric utility or gas utility connections and thereby operate totally “off the grid.”

- Museum/Visitor Center
- 6 offices/Conference Room & Staff Workshop Space
- Student and Staff Restrooms
