

# **High School Credit Recovery Options**

## **Within Albuquerque Public Schools**

**APS Class:** Take the class during the regular school day. Check with your school counselor to see if there is space available and if it will work within student's schedule and graduation requirements. *No cost.*

**APS eCADEMY:** Registration for eCADEMY High School classes is offered throughout the school year. Students meet with their School Counselor for a registration information. (eCADEMY phone number is 247-4209). Located at 5300 Cutler NE-I-40 and San Mateo. Visit the website for more information; go to [www.aps.edu](http://www.aps.edu) and type in "eCADEMY" in the search option. *Cost is \$25/session.*

**APS Summer School:** Information (dates, course offerings, cost, and location) is typically available in late April. There are many courses offered and classes fill quickly, so listen to announcements at your school site and check regularly on the APS Summer School Site or through your Counseling Office. A half credit course will meet 5 days/week for 4 hours per day for about 3 weeks. Students must obtain pre-registration paperwork from their APS counselor. *Cost is about \$200.00 per 1/2 credit.*

**APS Schools of Choice:** Alternative schools may provide the flexibility students need to "catch up" on credits. Students remain at home school until they are officially accepted at the "School of Choice" School (i.e. Freedom, eCADEMY, NextGen, etc.). Students can graduate from a "School of Choice" school, or stay a semester and return to their home school. For more information, go to [www.aps.edu](http://www.aps.edu) and type in Schools of Choice in the "search" option. *No Cost. Some Schools of Choice offer evening/online/summer classes for a fee, please check with your school counselor.*

## **Outside of Albuquerque Public Schools**

**Charter Schools:** Students may attend Charter Schools full-time, take summer school, evening or on-line courses. Check with APS and State Dept. of Education ([www.ped.state.nm.us](http://www.ped.state.nm.us)) for a list or go to [www.aps.edu](http://www.aps.edu) and type in "Charter Schools" in the search option. All base enrollment on a lottery system. Make sure the charter school is approved for credits within APS, before taking the classes. *No cost if you are enrolled fulltime with the charter school. Fees may occur for summer or online classes.*

**Private School:** Some private schools offer courses for a fee. Since not all of these schools are accredited, **it is very important that you verify that APS will accept their credits.** Check with your school counselor or your Assistant Principal of Curriculum to verify the credits will be accepted on your APS transcript toward graduation. *Costs vary with each school (about \$200.00 or more per 1/2 credit)*

**CNM/APS Dual Enrollment:** Classes may be taken at CNM or UNM for elective credit while in high school. See your school counselor for Dual Enrollment process. At this point Dual Enrollment is of *no cost to qualifying APS students who meet the Dual enrollment process at the CNM/UNM.*
