- Established in 1995
- Serves an estimated 73,000 students and 143 schools
- **Disburses \$500,000** annually to support innovative classroom practices and educational opportunities
- .78¢ of every dollar raised goes directly into grant funding
- 3 APS students sit on the Foundation's board of directors with full board and voting privileges
- Recipient of the Platinum Seal of Transparency from Candid/GuideStar. This prestigious honor is only awarded to charities demonstrating the highest level of responsive fiscal management and commitment to full accountability and transparency.

- 68.6% of students are eligible for free/reduced priced lunches
- 57 different languages are spoken in the homes of APS students
- 107 of the 143 schools in APS are Title I schools
- APS employs between 11,000 12,000 people. Approximately 5,000 of those are teachers


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UNRESTRICTED

These funds are subject to donor-imposed restrictions and include funds that are managed by the Foundation to meet the expectations of the donor.

These funds include those where the Foundation serves as the nonprofit sponsor under a sponsorship agreement with a district program.
