Individuals may apply for up to \$1,500 and school teams may apply for up to \$5,000 for projects supporting one of four focus areas – Literacy, Fine Arts, Middle and High School Clubs or Activities, and STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math). Financial literacy is also included in this cycle.

Teachers who won Fall 2012 grants are ineligible but may apply again for the Fall 2013 cycle. **The application with original grant proposal attached plus five stapled copies of the grant proposal** may be dropped off at the **Foundation's office in the APS administration building, 6400 Uptown Blvd., Suite 630E**, or mailed to the **APS Education Foundation, P.O. Box 25704, Albuquerque, NM, 87125-0704**.
