Collet Park Elementary School



Playground includes an outdoor game area near gigantic chimes!

This playground was built for the autism program at Collet Park ES. It includes a ramped structure with sensory play components (sounds, lights, or tactile elements).



Kids' ZONE

Coyote Willow Family School



The ramped structure was built with inclusive play in mind. It includes play components for kids of all abilities along the ramped structure, as well as autism specific play components.



Engineered wood fiber provides a safe fall surface and is wheelchair accessible.



Valle Vista Elementary School

The ramped structure was installed in the first phase of a multi-phase campus renovation. This play structure sits underneath one of the largest shade structures in the District and was built to give play access to the special needs population. It includes play components on the inside and outside, allowing more kids to use the structure at the same time.
