

# APS . . . to the Point

This is the second issue featuring New ADA Compliant playgrounds. The following NEW “inclusive design” upgrades provide equal access to all children regardless of mobility limitations.

## Chaparral Elementary School



This is one of the largest ramped play structures in the District. It contains play activities for all levels of kids, and includes a wide variety of equipment that works and strengthens different muscle groups (such as overhead activities for upper body strength and beams for balancing). The structure is ramped all the way to the top, so kids of all levels can get in the action.

## Whittier Elementary School



Whittier's ADA playground is a hybrid ramped structure that is tied into the schools existing playground. By integrating the two together FD+C was able to include more equipment into the playground pod.



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## Aztec Special Education and Autism Center



The Aztec Center provides services to some of the most intensive needs students in the District. The playground surfacing is poured-in-rubber and the area is covered by large shade structures. The campus also includes fitness/strength training equipment and a separate pre-kindergarten play area.
