

APS Title I Donna Beegle Poverty Awareness Training Full Day Session for School Teams

School teams of 8-12 members attend a *free*, one-day training presented by APS Title I team members

This training is designed for school teams that have <u>not</u> yet attended a full-day Poverty Awareness Training.

The session will help school staff:

- √ develop an awareness of poverty, its issues and challenges
- √ study the long term effects poverty has on students
- ✓ learn strategies to build and strengthen relationships to improve academic achievement and positive outcomes
- ✓ create an action plan specifically designed for your school community

Who should be part of our school Poverty Awareness Team?

We require a minimum of one administrator and recommend that front office staff, nurses, counselors, teachers and educational assistants attend as well.

- Title I provides attendees with a working lunch during the session
- Title I pays for substitutes for sessions during the school year
- Follow-up session/coaching is available to your school site
- Title I pays stipends for coaching sessions outside of the duty day
