

What We Do...

The Employee Assistance Program is a benefit of the Albuquerque Public Schools to employees and their immediate family members. EAP provides a confidential setting in which employees and their families can discuss problems, as well as receive help in finding community resources to meet their needs.



The primary goal of the EAP is to provide services to help employees maintain their productivity on the job. These services include:

- Short-term individual, family, and couples counseling
- Referral to community resources to resolve physical, mental health, substance abuse, personal and/or family issues
- Assistance to administrators/supervisors in the management of troubled employee, team building, training, and mediation.

Can EAP Help Me?

The Employee Assistance Program offers help to APS employees in times of stress. Employees use EAP services for many different reasons. Some are having marriage or family problems. Some are struggling with job pressures, interpersonal conflicts, work-related issues, anxiety or depression. Some are dealing with a serious illness or loss. Whatever the reason for seeking help, APS employees will receive confidential counseling from our highly experienced professional staff.

The EAP counselors specialize in helping individuals/families through:

- Stress or life crises
- Workplace conflict
- Mediation
- Couples/family issues
- Crisis intervention
- Grief and loss
- Domestic violence
- Alcohol and other drug use



The services provided directly by the EAP counselors are free to all employees and their immediate family members (partner and children ages 13-18). Fees and expenses incurred as a result of community referrals are the responsibility of the employee.

Is It Confidential?

Confidentiality is a cornerstone of the Employee Assistance Program. Information shared by an employee will be kept confidential unless written permission is given by the employee. The following are exceptions:

- known or suspected child abuse
- danger to self or others


