
REQUESTED ACTION: Consideration of Ratification of the Negotiated Agreement between the Board of Education of the Albuquerque Municipal School District Number 12 and the Albuquerque Teachers Federation (Discussion/Action)


BACKGROUND: The district and Albuquerque Teachers Federation (ATF) meet annually to negotiate the bargaining agreement.

The bargaining unit consists of approximately 6,602 employees in the bargaining unit (5,648 teachers and librarians and 810 Support and Related Personnel).

It is the intention of the Board of Education and ATF to respect the collective bargaining process and as such the parties have reached a tentative agreement and, therefore, requests the Board of Education's ratification of the 2019-2020 Negotiated Agreement.




