OPEN FORUM

1. Valerie Slow, parent, spoke. She is a member of the Pueblo of Laguna Department of Education School Board. One of goals of the School Board is to do a better job of advocating for the Pueblo of Laguna students attending APS. Her child attends MacArthur ES which does not have an Indian Education Resource Teacher. She would like to see better communication to get more parents to attend the parent meetings. She would like to know the indicator to offer other Native Languages in APS besides Navajo and Zuni.
The Director responded that the Indian Education Department has tried to initiate offering the Keres Language. There are different dialects of the Keres Language spoken in various pueblos, and each of those pueblos have indicated they want their own dialect taught, i.e., the Keres dialect spoken in the Pueblo of Santo Domingo/Kewa would be offered to only those students from that Pueblo and not to students from other Keres-speaking pueblos. At this time, there are not enough students from the Pueblo of Santo Domingo/Kewa to justify hiring a Keres Language Teacher. The Chairperson is also the Parent Representative from the Pueblo of Zuni. She made several trips to the Pueblo to get approval for the Indian Education Department to offer the Zuni Language. They also have stipulated that only Pueblo of Zuni students may enroll in the class.
