## !! Hepatitis B Immunization Alert for Parents !!

Hepatitis B shots have been added to the school immunization law beginning in 1999 and as part of day care regulations in 2000. The requirement will be phased in over a three-year period.

- Sept.1, 1999 Seventh graders will need to have completed the three-dose series of hepatitis B shots before entering school.
- Sept.1, 2000 Children 12 months or older in state-licensed daycare centers will need to have completed the three-dose series of hepatitis B shots.
- Sept.1, 2002 All children entering kindergarten or school for the first time will need to have completed the three-dose series of hepatitis B shots before entering school.

Make sure your children have all their shots! Ask your doctor or nurse at your child's clinic!
