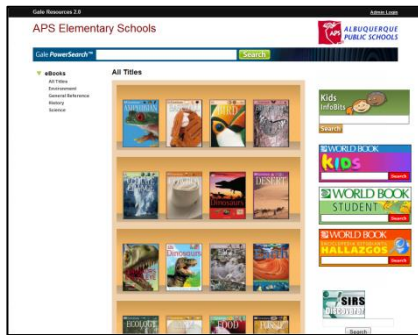

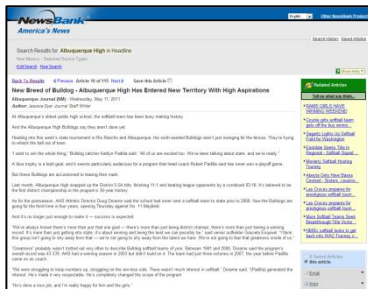


Graphic interface works well on tablets; designed for elementary students.
