CNM Intersession begins on April 26th, 2021

- Intersession students should fill out the online textbook order form, [Where Is My Textbook](#). **Library Services will reply to the form with an email confirmation when the textbooks are ready for pickup. If you do not receive a reply, fill out another form.**
- Intersession students should pick up their required materials at the CNM Bookstore **AFTER THEY FILL OUT THE ONLINE FORM & RECEIVE CONFIRMATION THAT THEIR MATERIALS ARE READY FOR PICK UP. CNM regular summer term begins May 17th, 2021

- APS dual credit students should register for dual credit classes as early as possible and fill out the online textbook order form, [Where Is My Textbook](#). **Library Services will reply to the form with an email confirmation when the textbooks are ready for pickup. If you do not receive a reply, fill out another form.**
- Textbooks should be ready for pickup at the CNM Bookstore about a week after registering for classes. **Students should receive a reply to their form when the textbooks are ready for pickup. - **UNM dual credit students should fill out the →→ [Where Is My Textbook](#) ←← to order textbooks.** The form captures email/ mailing addresses for textbooks/online codes, and all textbook issues. **Replies may take up to 1 business day during the week and 2 days for weekend submissions.*
- **UNM STUDENTS ONLY: Digital textbooks will be emailed to the student's UNM email account; physical textbooks will be shipped to the mailing address provided in the online form.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **To get your textbook successfully, we recommend filling out our online form, [Where Is My Textbook](#), to order textbooks.** The online form helps us route requests to the right person in our department. **Replies may take up to 1 business day during the week and 2 days for weekend submissions.*
- Library Services purchases **eBook** versions of required textbooks whenever possible. If a student requires a physical textbook in lieu of an eBook, a school representative must email valerie.valdez@aps.edu approving the need for a physical textbook.
- APS students taking CNM dual credit classes must go to the CNM Main Campus Bookstore to obtain their textbooks.
