Question 1:

Answer 1:

All of the underlined suffixes are correct.

Question 2:

Per your request of 20 Gbps minimum to start, I assume you will be able to handle a 100 Gbps interface on your equipment?

Answer 2:

Per the SoW, APS is asking for scalable service **up to 20 Gbps** with the potential of requiring more than 20 Gbps by the end of the contract. The district currently has 10 and 40 Gbps interfaces. It is not expected that the district will require more than 40 Gbps of Internet access in the next five years.
