APPENDIX B SCOPE OF WORK

1. Food & Nutrition Services Central Kitchen and Storage–Remodel 800 Louisiana

Preliminary Scope: To remodel 800 Louisiana to accommodate dry storage (recently moved from the Washington Warehouse to 800 Louisiana), freezer space, central kitchen, offices and all associated spaces. When completed, this building will provide adequate space for the consolidation of **all** F&N services including functions currently housed at the Rankin Warehouse and Lincoln Complex. In addition, the site must be organized to accommodate staff parking, APS vehicles and the smooth ingress and egress of all delivery vehicles.

2. Re-roof of building “M” Lincoln Complex

The re-roofing of approximately 85,000 square feet of metal building located in the Lincoln Complex. This is to be a standing seam metal roof over an existing roof with no tear off.

3. South pre-K-8 School (Prototype)

Preliminary Scope: To design a K-8 School to eliminate elementary and middle school overcrowding in the SW quadrant of the District. The campus will be comprised of 64 classrooms (with the option to add 10 classrooms if funding allows), shared gym, shared kitchen/cafeteria, and shared multi-media center. There will be additional specialized spaces as required by the different grade levels. The building(s) will be minimum LEED Silver.

This project is intended to be a prototypical design. The first school will open in fall of 2014. The successful architectural firm will be paid a reuse fee for each additional school. The reuse fee will be fixed at the time this contract is negotiated.

The school will be located on property owned by the District directly south of Atrisco Heritage Academy High School.

This is for design only. The construction is contingent on successful passage of the February 2013 Bond Election.
