# RESPONSE TO TECHNICAL QUESTIONS SUBMITTED

1. Please provide some background as to why this procurement is taking place mid-year. Is the District currently providing this service themselves and why is it stopping mid-year?

# Answer:

APS released an RFI in July 2014 and there were no contractors interested in assuming the (Albuquerque) East Mountain Area routes at that time. APS was then forced to acquire the buses and provide student transportation services in the East Mountain area. Nearing the mid-year point of the school year, we inquiring if there is new interest to acquire those buses in order to provide services in that area as student transportation is not the District's core competency.

2. Is the successful proposer eligible for State bus rental fees for the 18 buses purchased from the District? If so, for how many years?

## Answer:

No. The reason is that they will acquire the buses for a fraction of the cost (Approx. \$45K) as opposed to the appraised value of over \$400K. Any new buses purchased after the new company acquires the operation will have Rental Fee/Purchase Allowance.

3. What coverage limits for liability insurance are provided by APS for the school buses?

# Answer:

The coverage limit provided by risk management is one million dollars for liability. We are self-insured and self-administered for the first \$350,000 and have excess coverage for the remainder. We proved physical damage coverage in the form of collision and comprehensive coverage. The damage deductible for the collision and comprehensive is \$750.00 for each bus.

4. What documentation is the District asking a Proposer to provide in order to demonstrate "Authority to Provide Student Transportation Services" as outlined on page 27 of the RFP?

5. Are the 18 buses to be purchased powered by diesel fuel?

6. On page 20, the RFP states that the contractor will be responsible for 36 routes. Does each bus run two routes in the morning and two in the afternoon?

# Answer:

Some buses only have one route due to the length of the route. Other buses have two and three routes.

7. Are there any mid-day kindergarten routes or shuttles?

## Answer:

There is one bus that has a midday Pre-K route that delivers students home.
