1. Q: My wife is an APS teacher but looking at the definition on the contract she does not meet the parts about conflict of interest. She has filled out a form with APS stating a non-conflict of interest or something like that I'm not sure. She is not employed by my company nor consults for it. The only thing is she is under my health insurance. Are we correct in stating there is no conflict of interest?

A: There should be no conflict of interest

2. Q: When we submit through the vendor registry will you be able to verify that it went through?

A: Confirm your Bid submission with Vendor Registry. Procurement is unable to confirm receipt of proposals until the opening date/ time.

3. Q. Under Insurance, is the following insurance is required to place this bid.  
14. INSURANCE (If Applicable): The successful Bidder shall (if applicable) purchase and maintain statutory limits of Worker's Compensation, and Public Liability and Automobile Liability insurance approved by APS at the time of contract award. APS shall be included as a loss payee and/or additional insured. Public Liability and Automobile Liability insurance shall include at least the following coverage:  
General Liability Insurance – per occurrence  
General Aggregate - \$2,000,000  
Product/completed operations aggregate \$1,000,000  
\$1,000,000  
Professional Liability Insurance (E&O)-per occurrence

Professional Aggregate - \$2,000,000  
\$2,000,000  
Bodily injury, per occurrence \$1,000,000  
Medical and medically-related expenses \$10,000

Vehicle bodily injury, each occurrence, excluding medical and medically related expenses  
\$750,000  
Property Damage, per occurrence \$1,000,000

A: The required insurance listed within the Bid is required.

4. Q: Which radios are you looking for equipment for, and are you looking to replace current radios or just fix an existing system?

A: The District is looking for Two Way Radios parts and repair for schools and departments on an as as-needed basis. This includes two-way radios; handheld (walkie talkie), mobile (fixed mount), and base stations. Repair might include any already existing two-way radio systems that might be in place at requesting locations within the District.
