3. Explain what would happen if you tried to plant your tree at a higher elevation. What about a lower elevation?

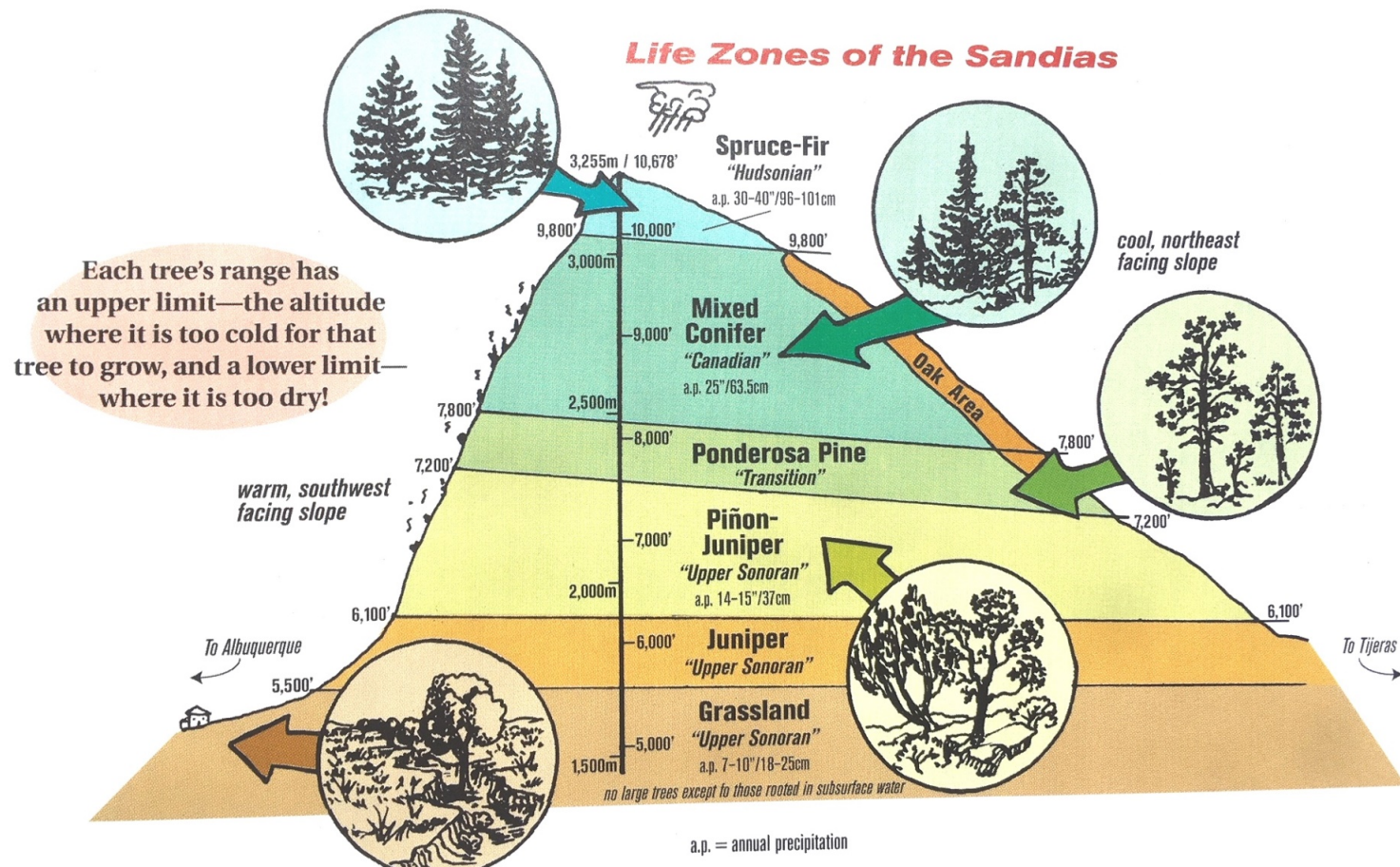
