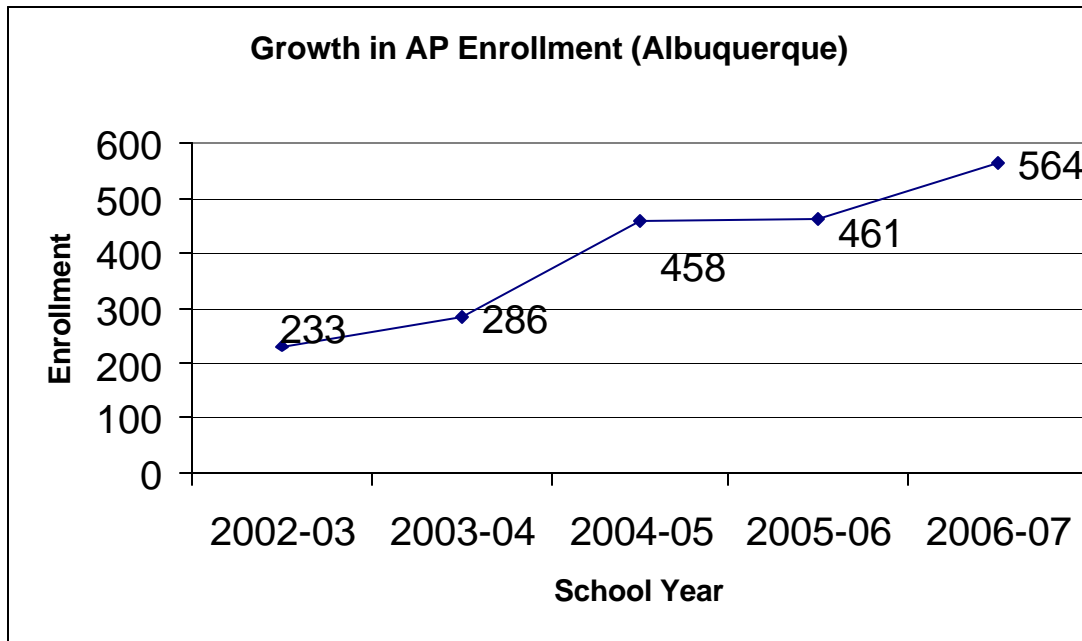


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

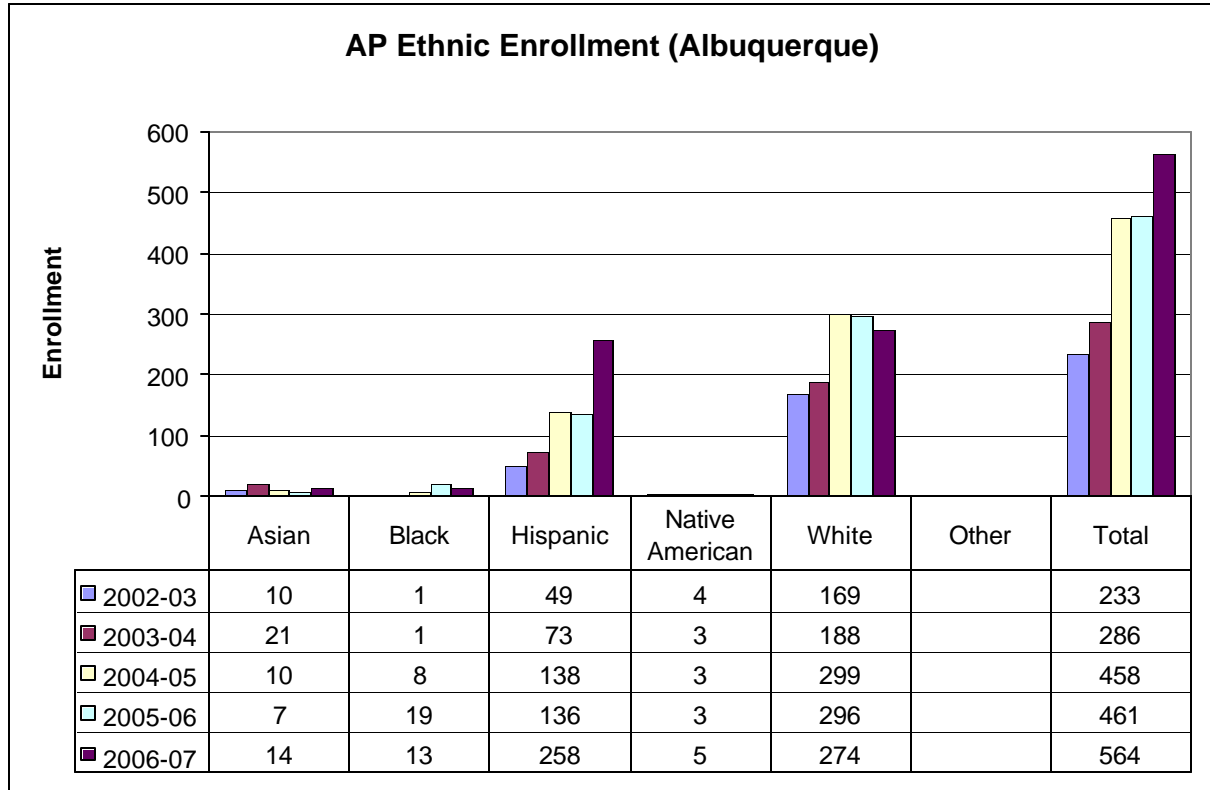


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

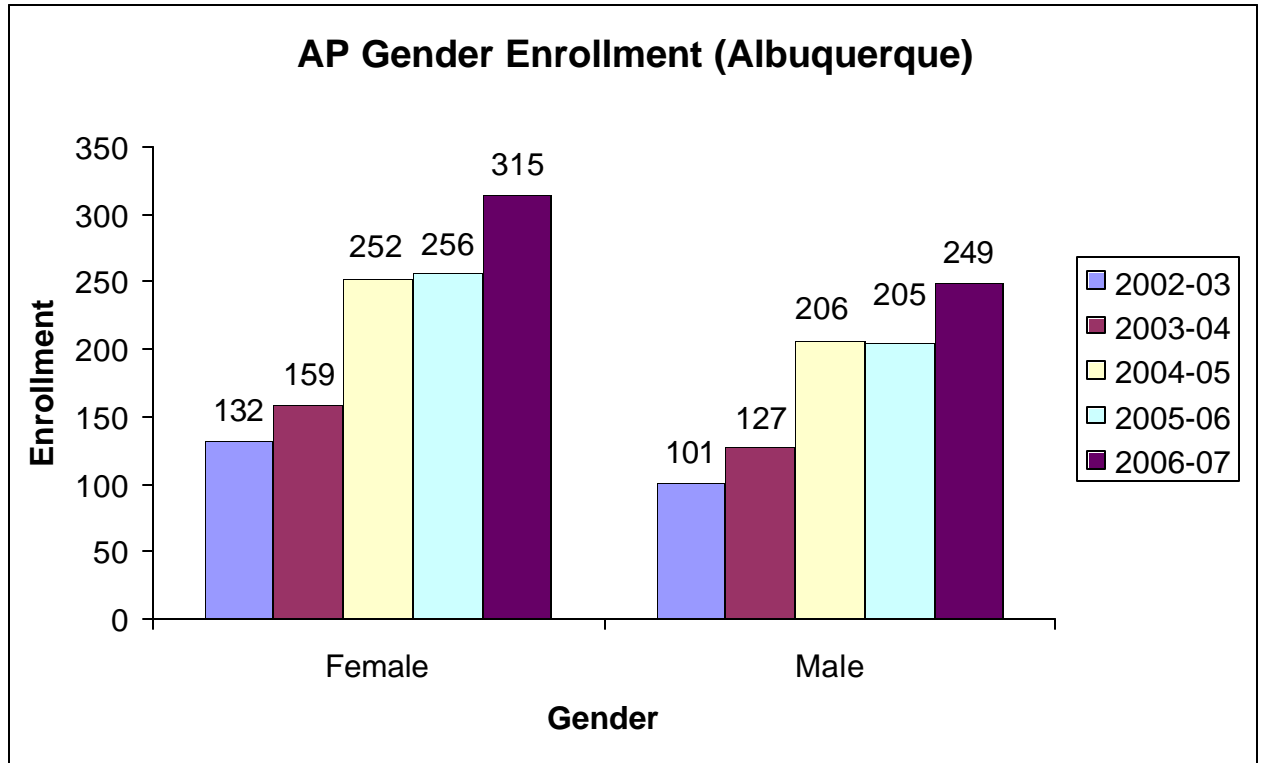

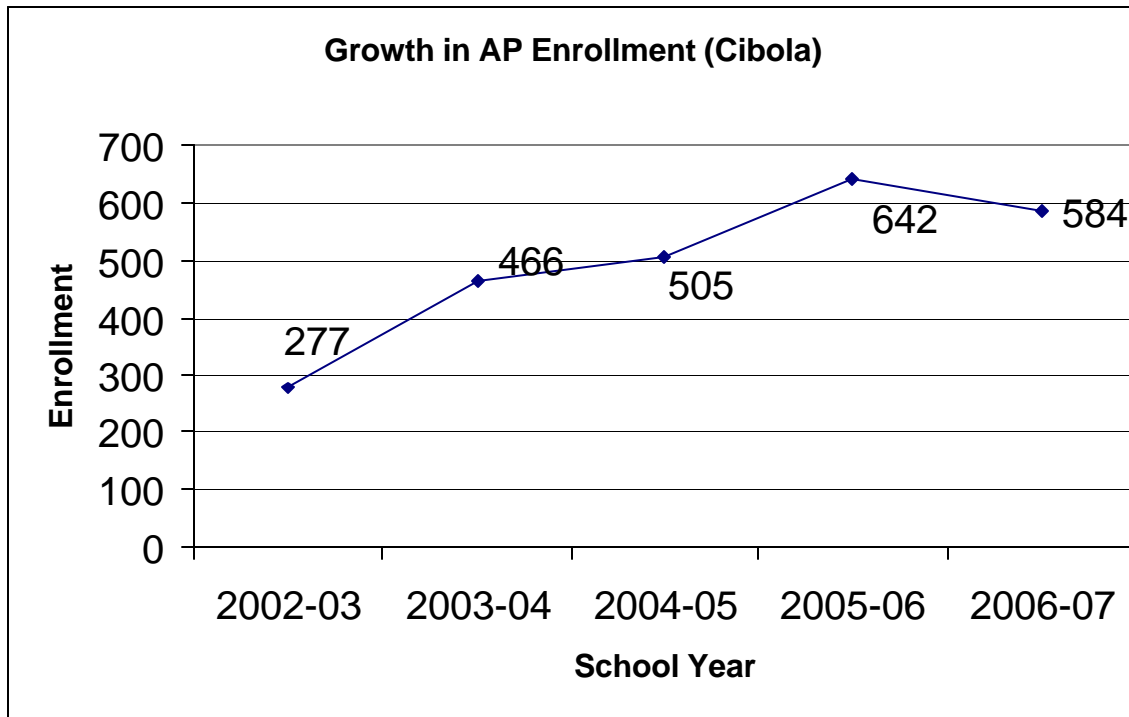


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

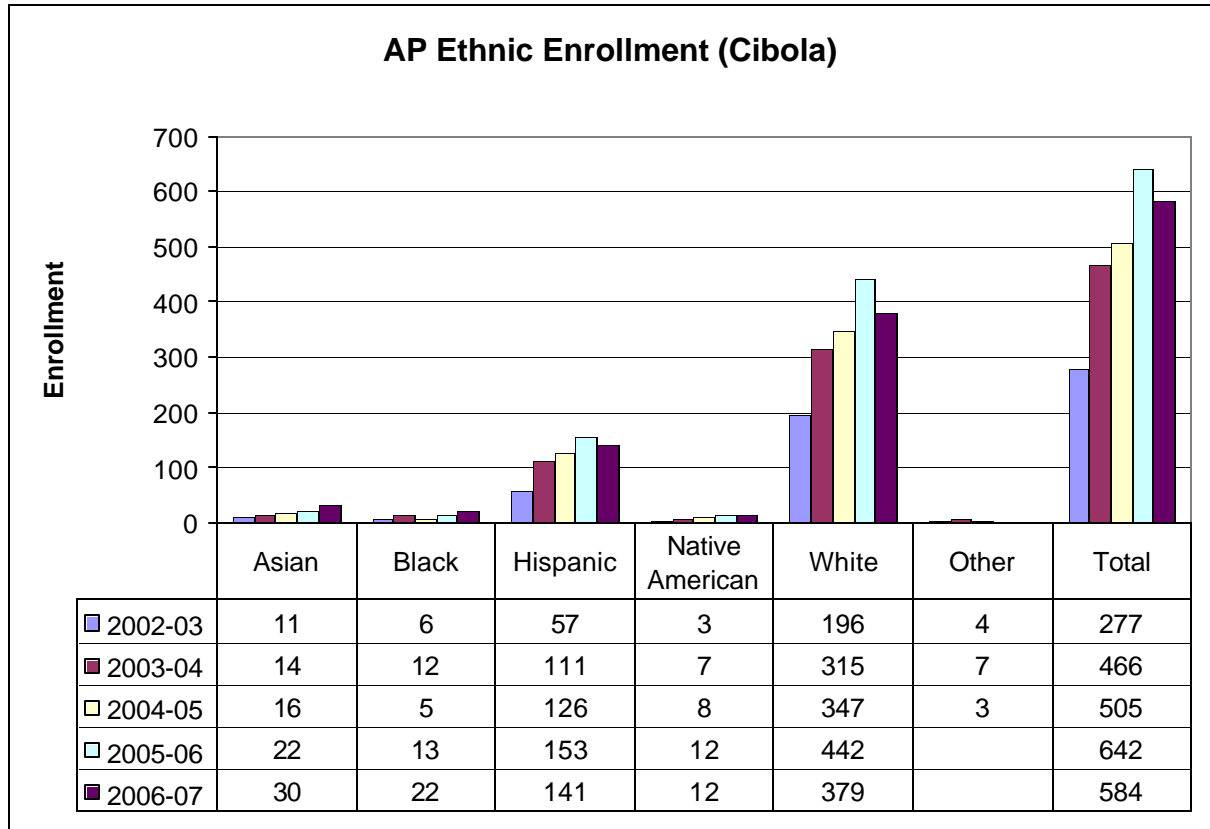


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

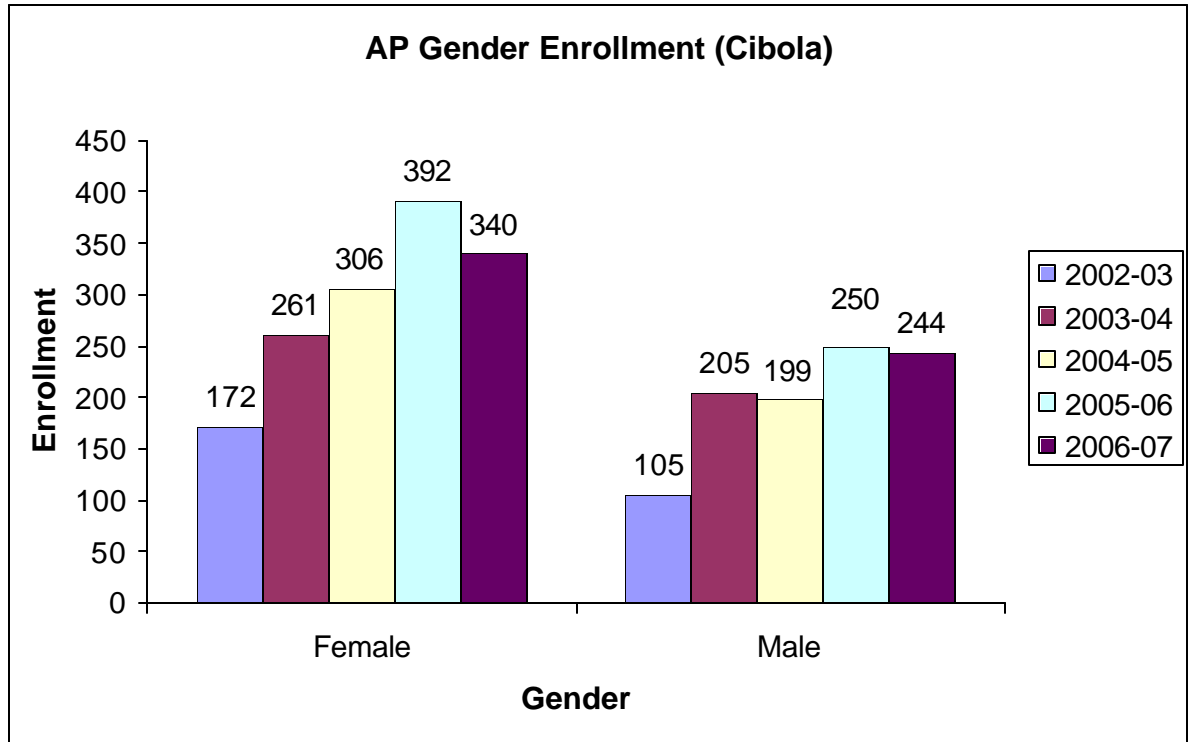

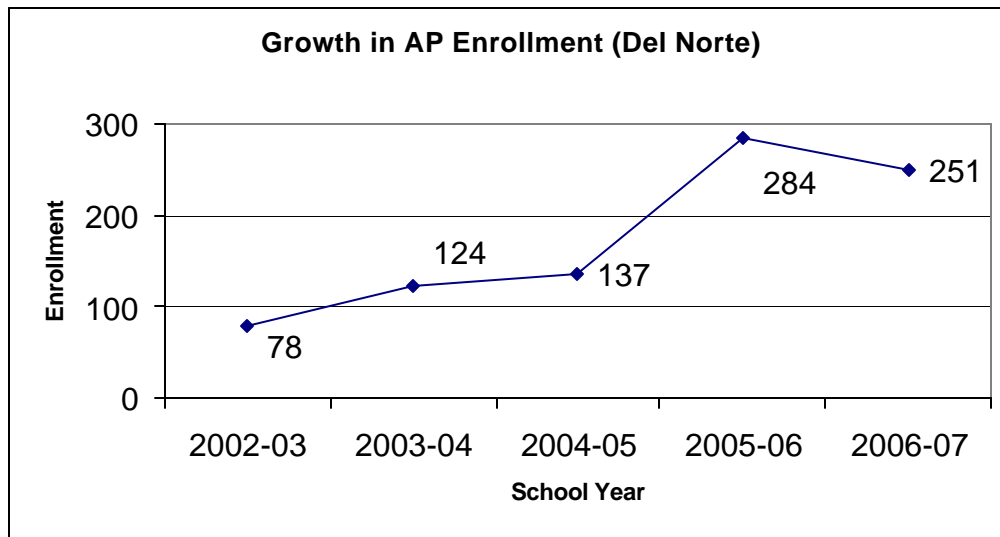


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

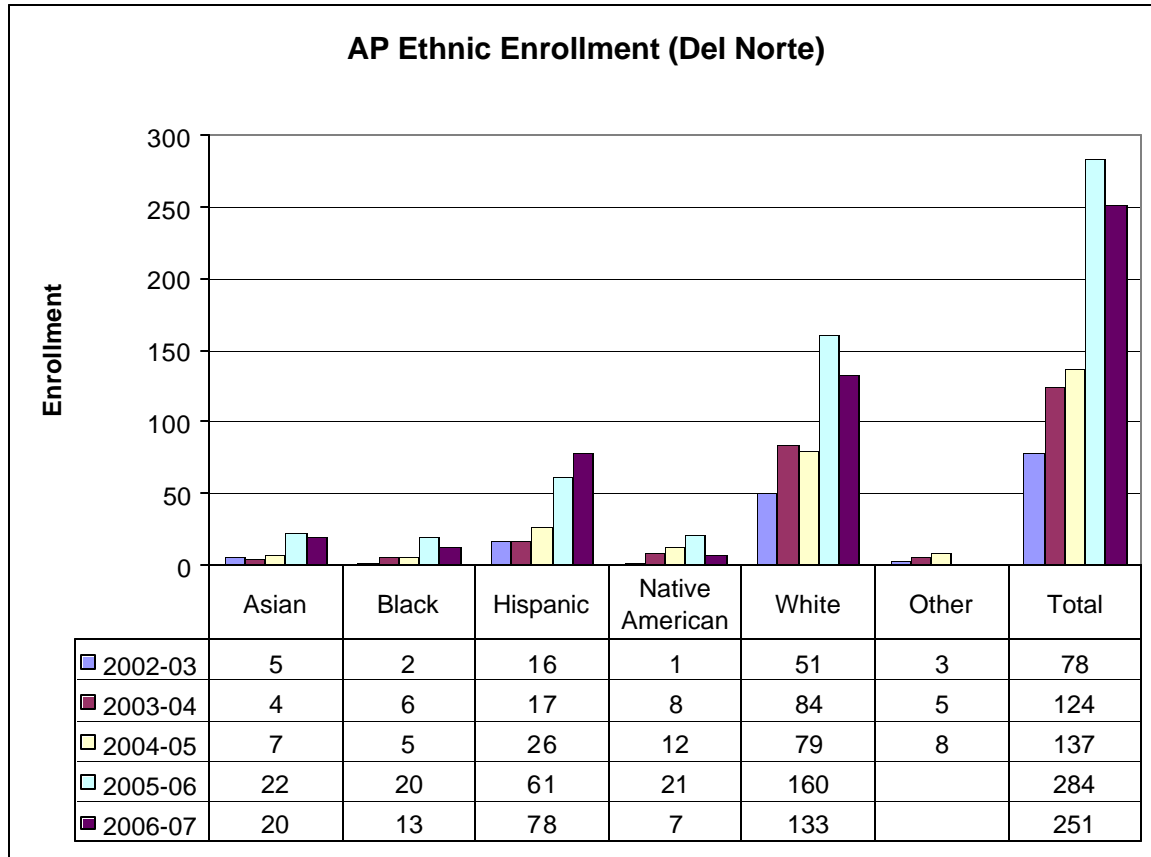


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

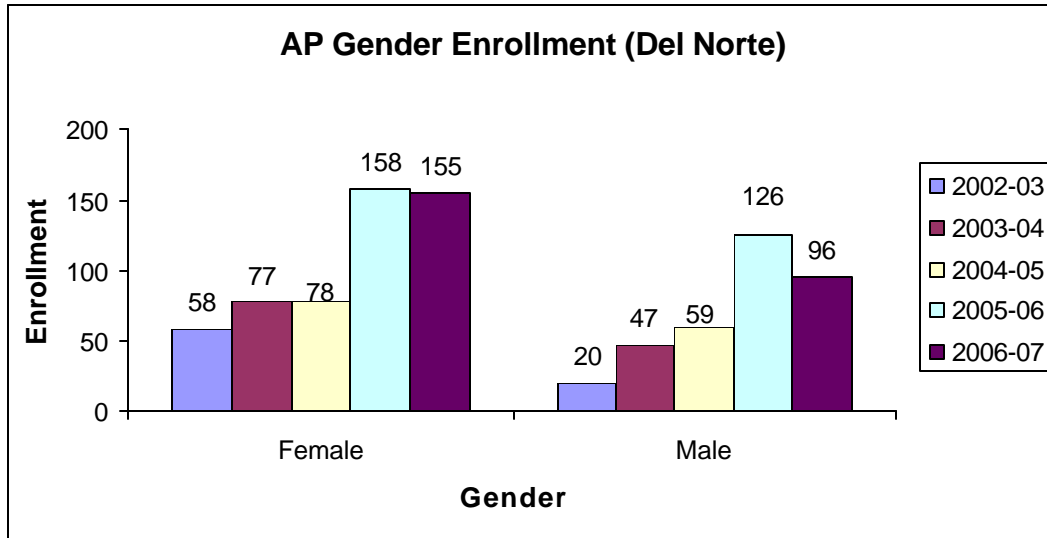

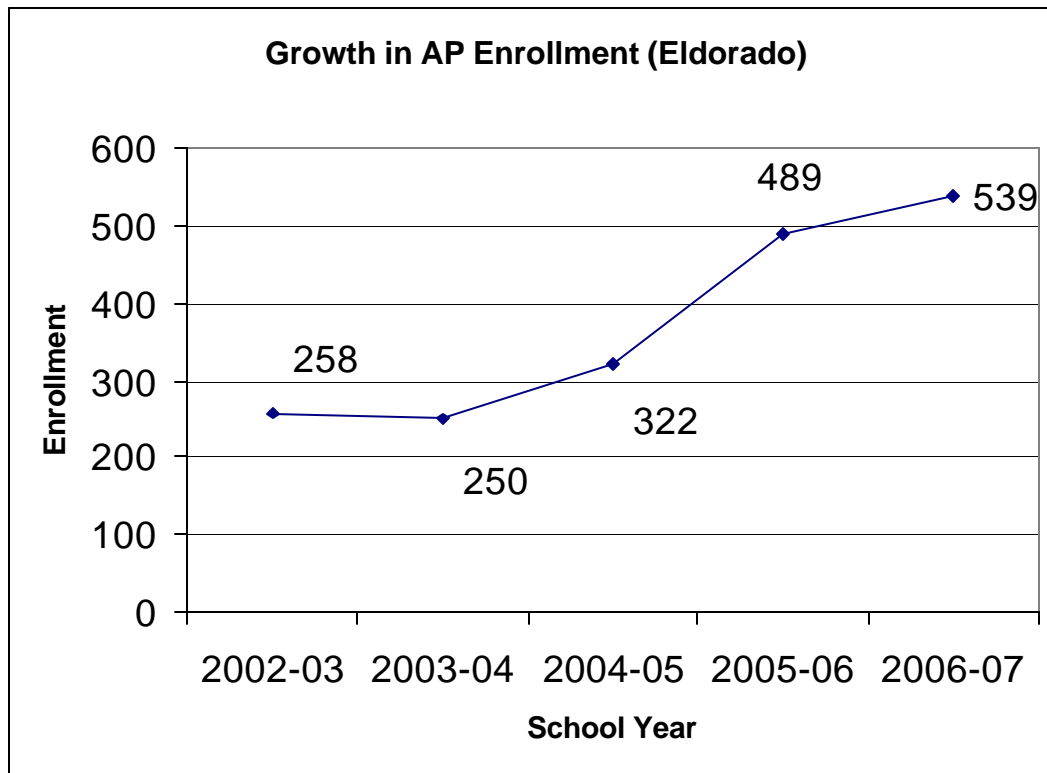


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

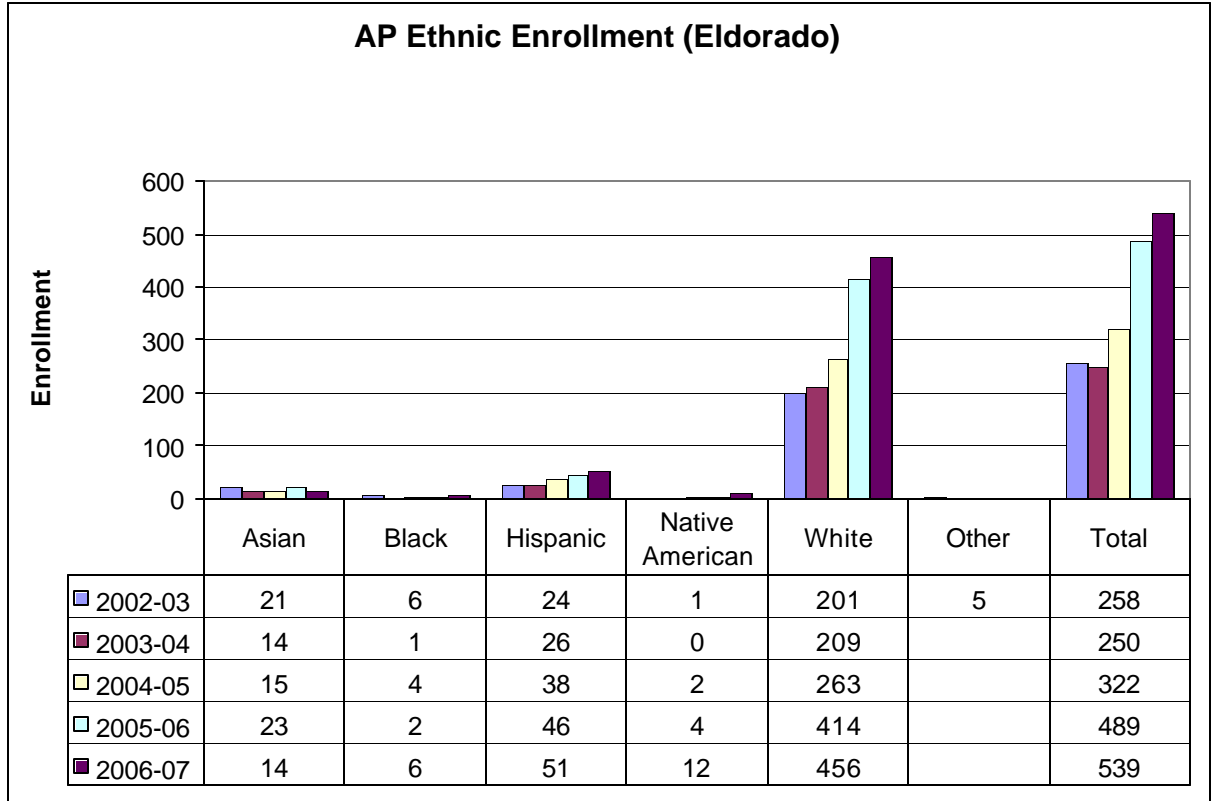


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

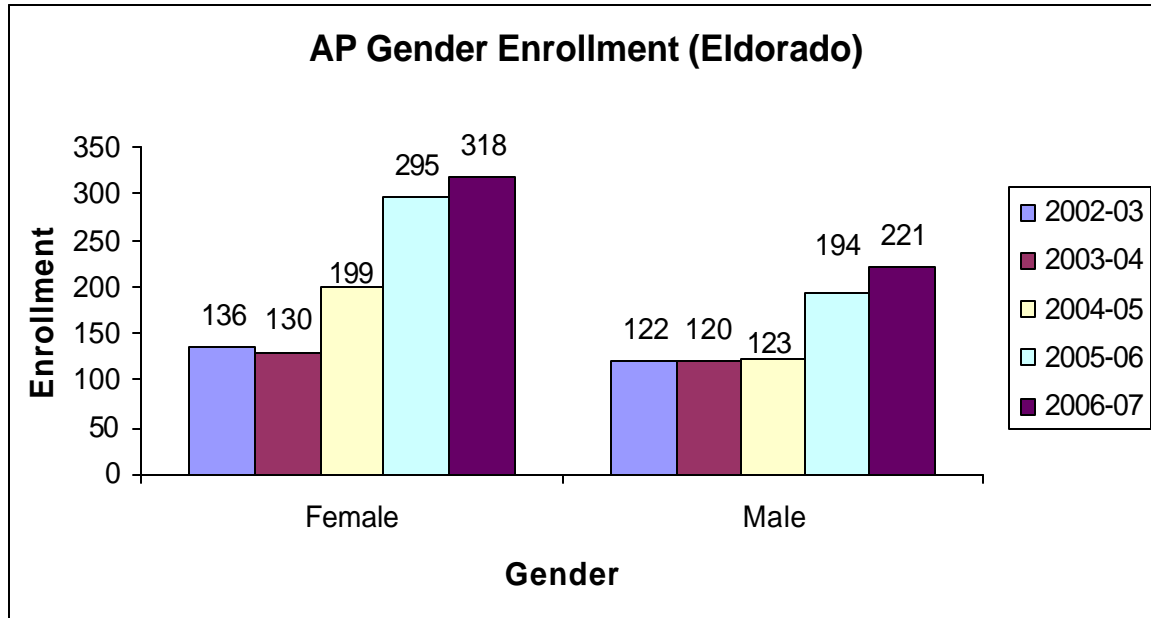

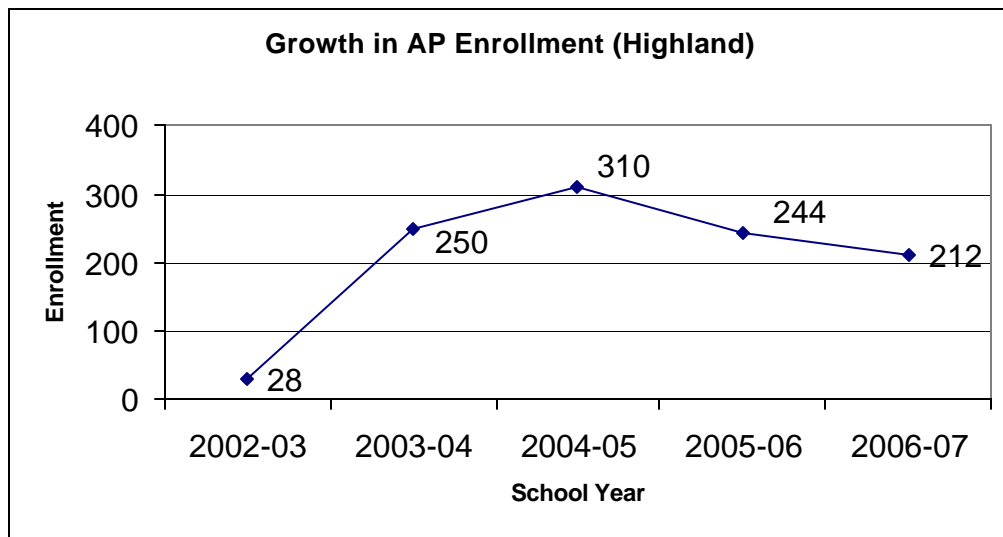


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

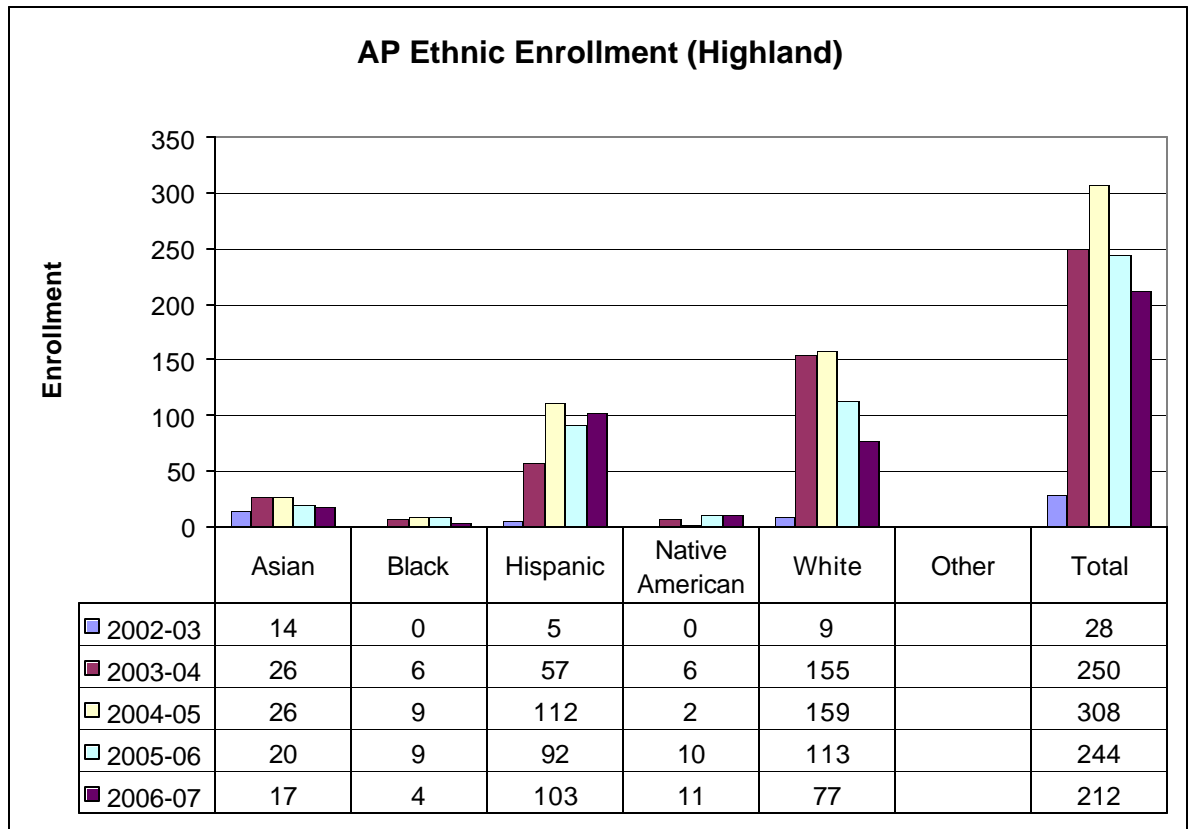


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

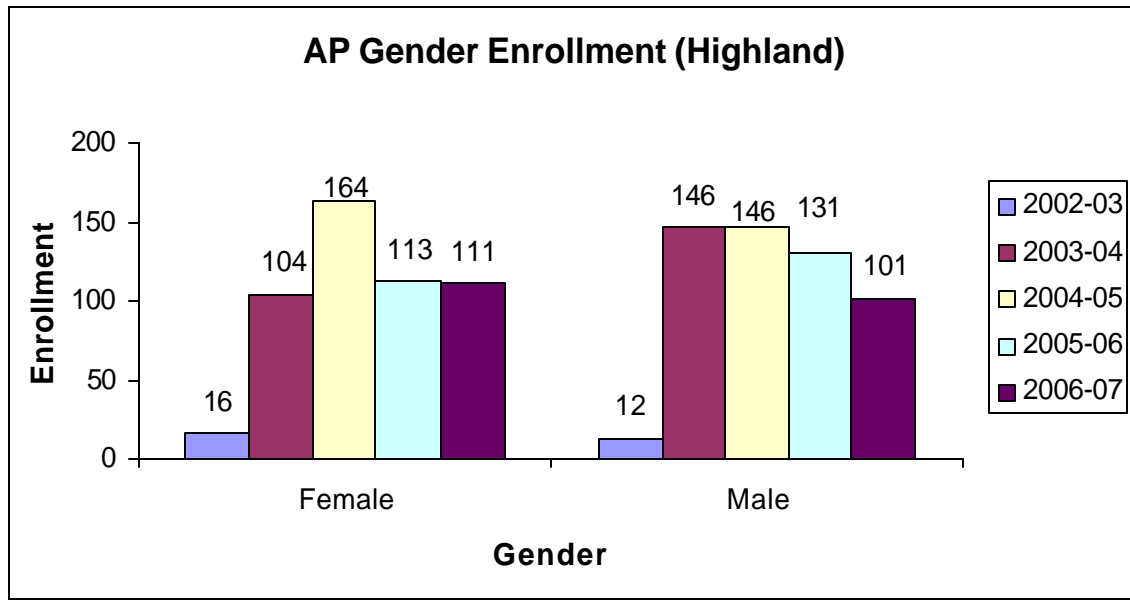

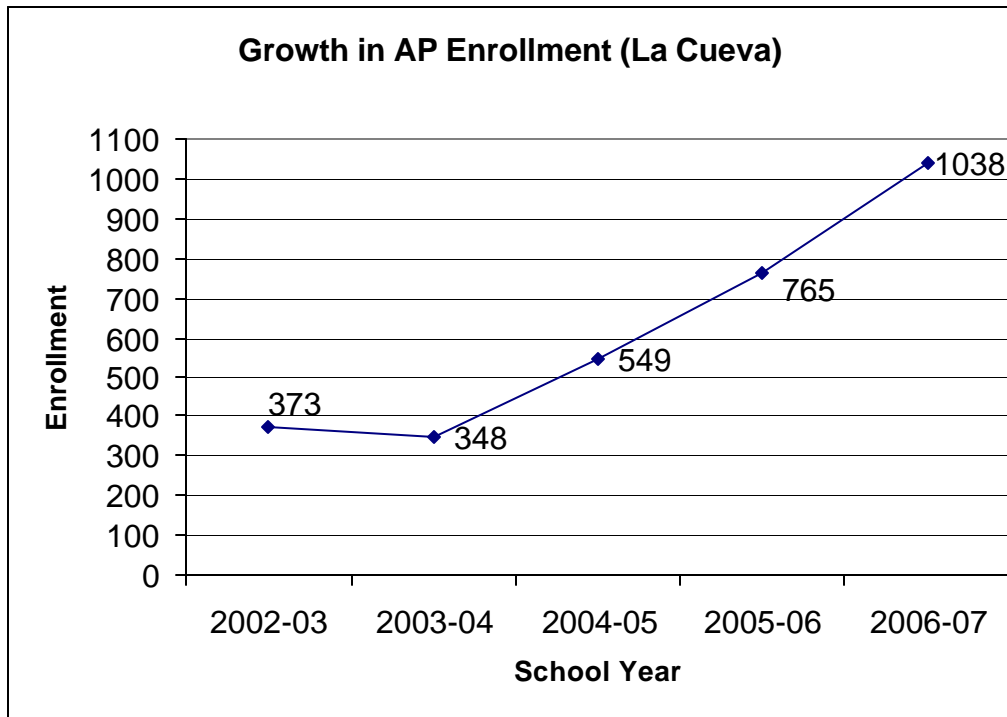


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

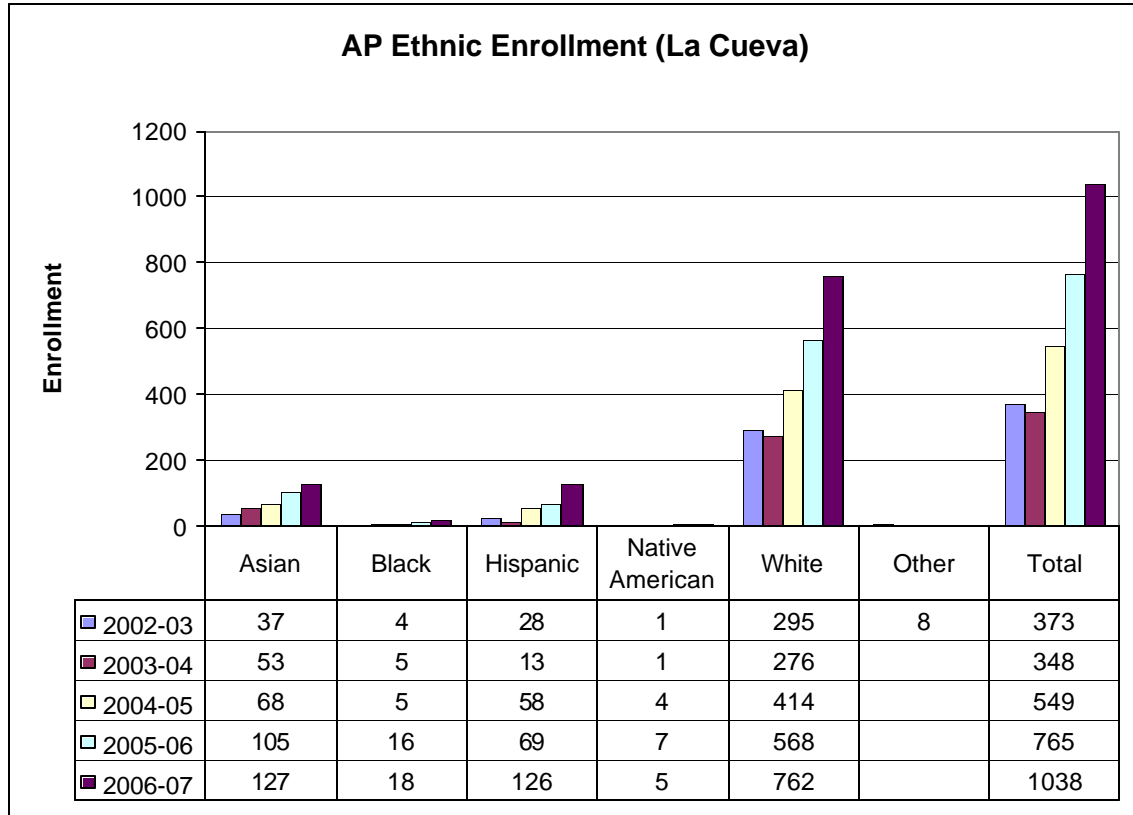


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

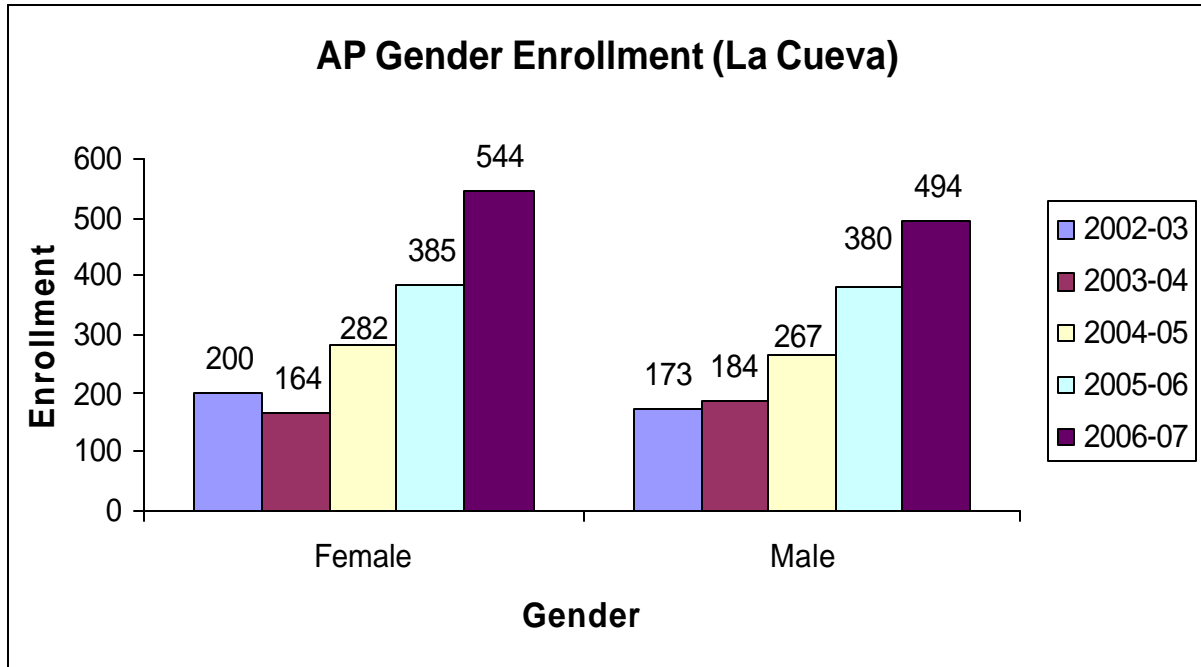

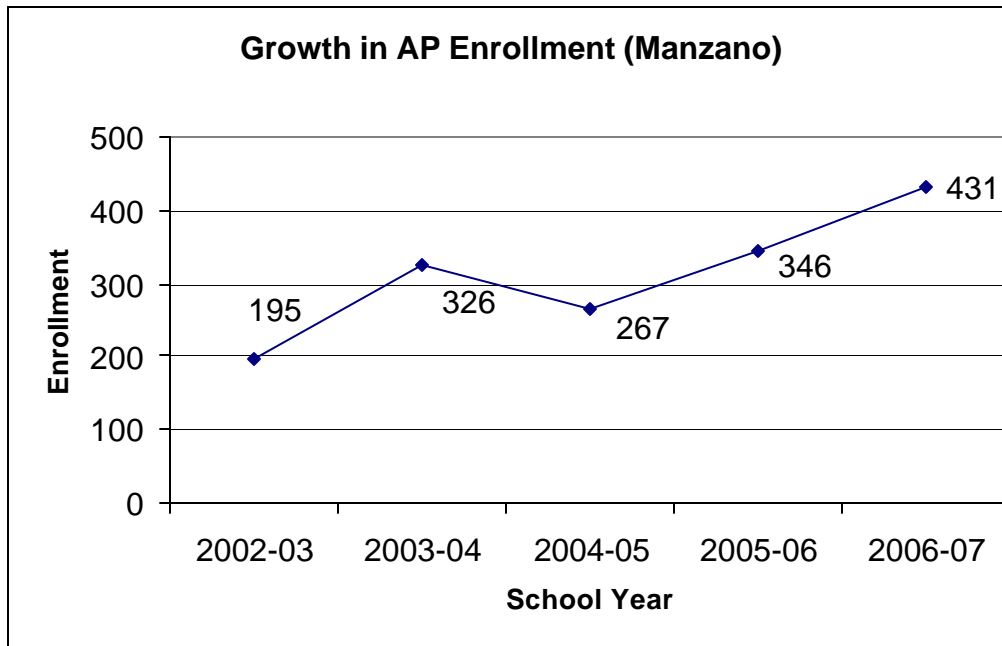


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

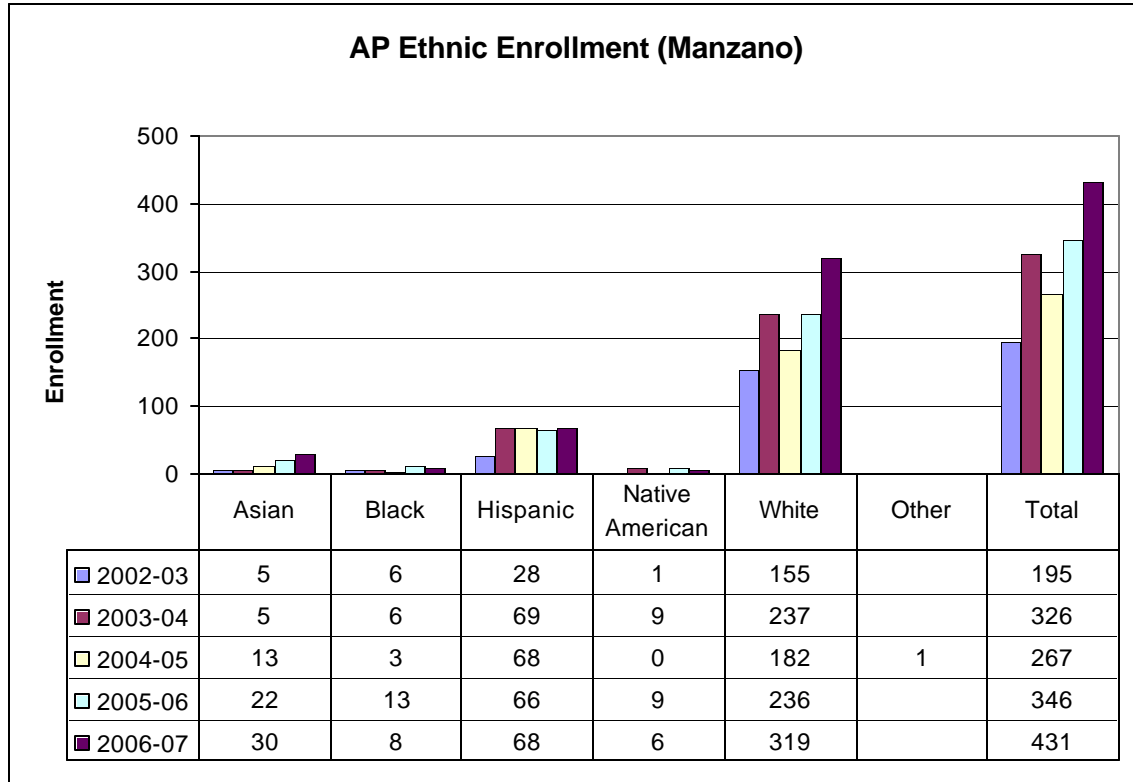


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

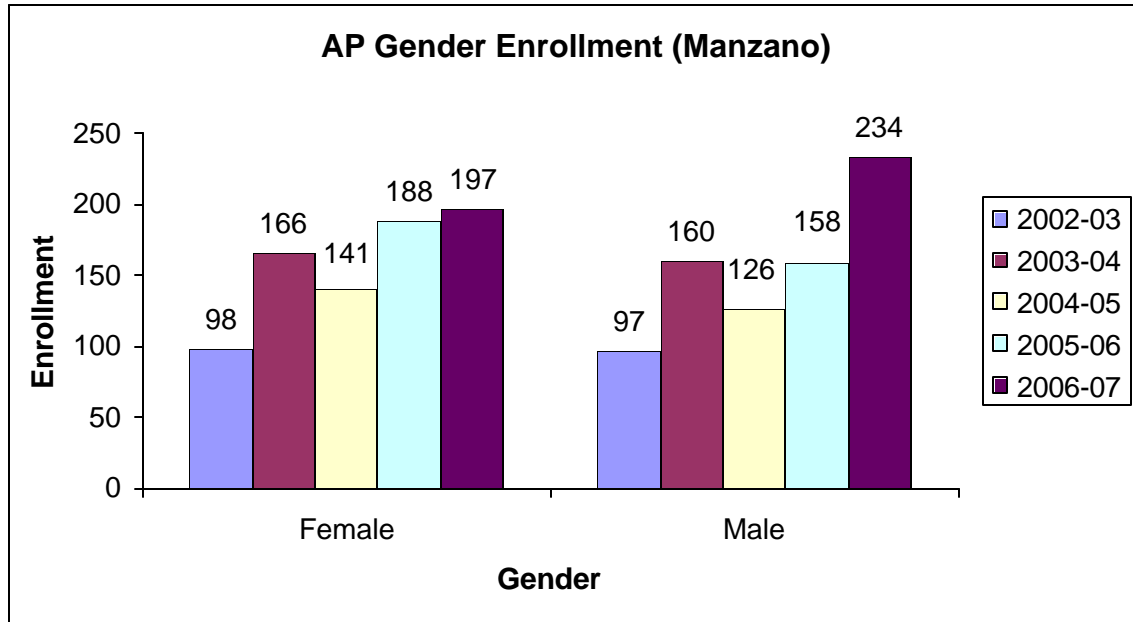

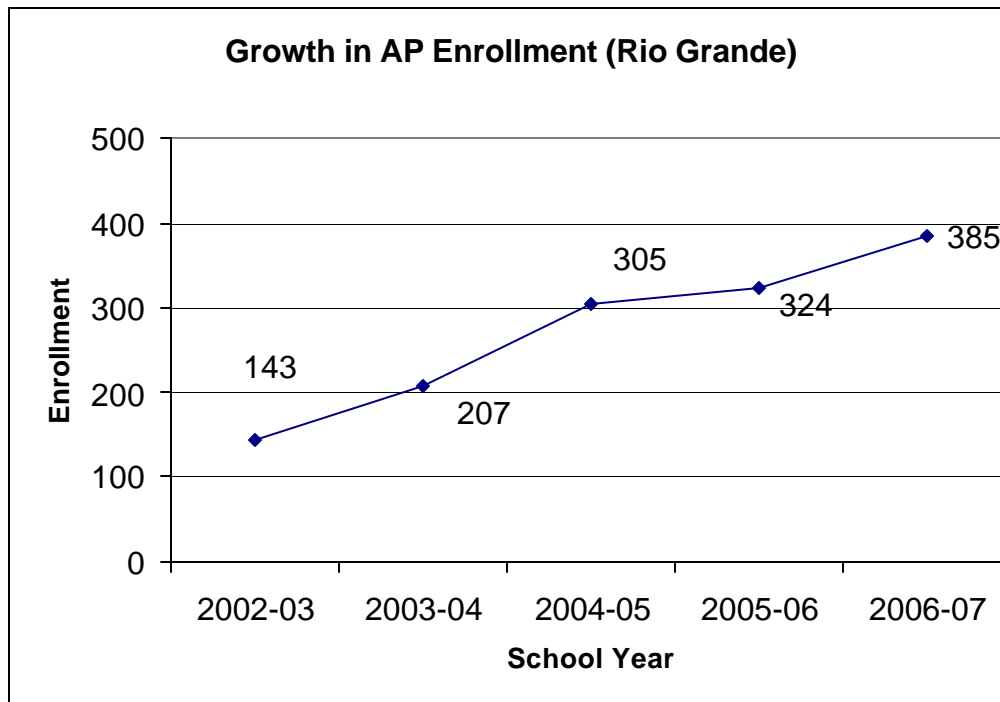


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

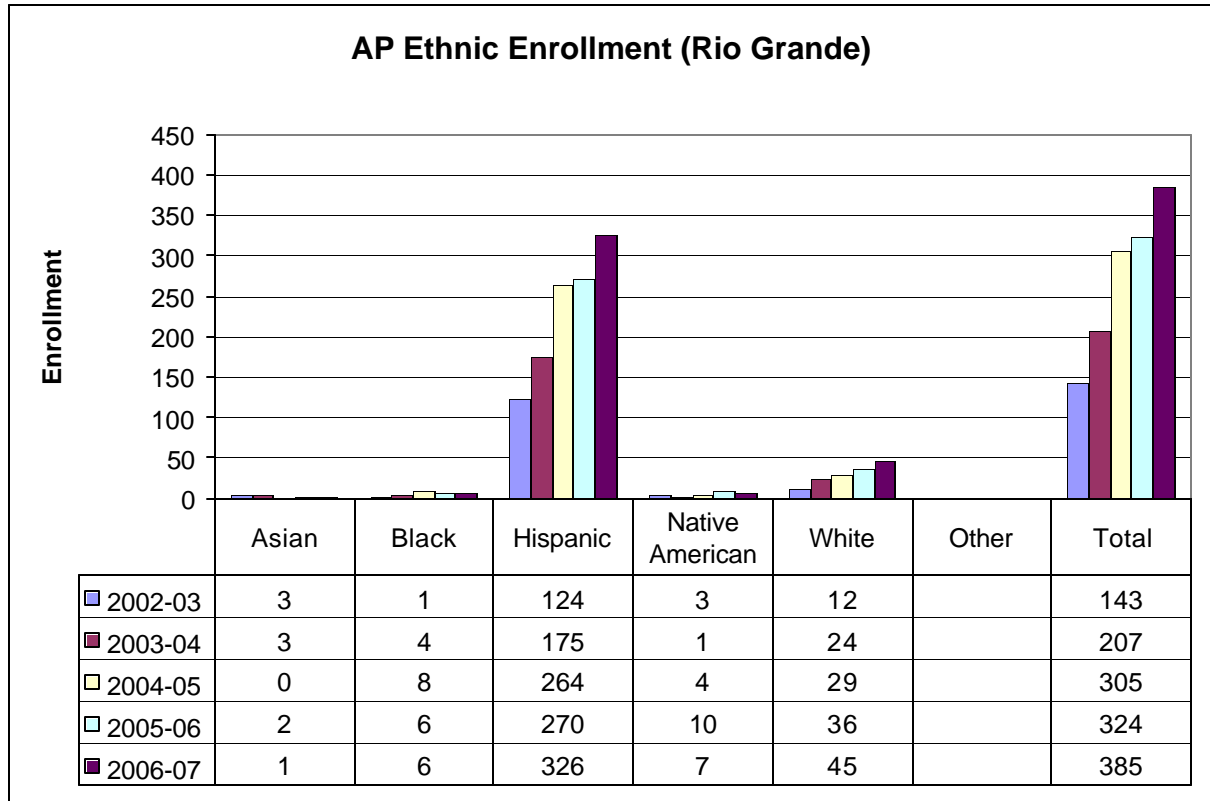


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

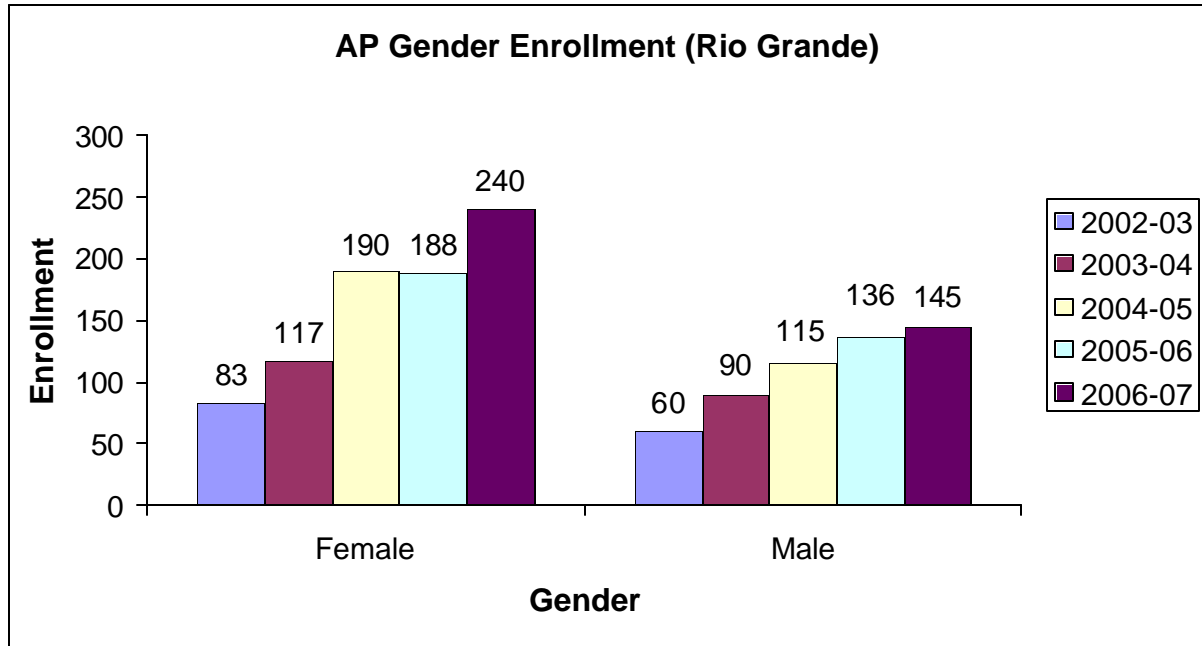

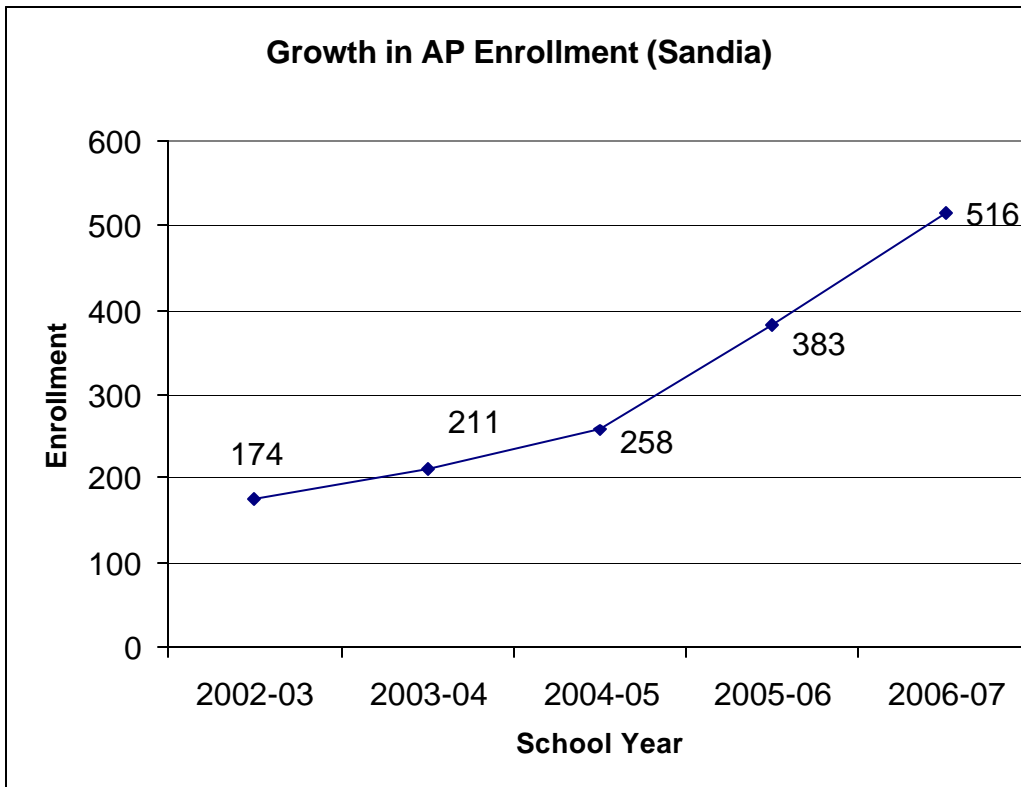


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

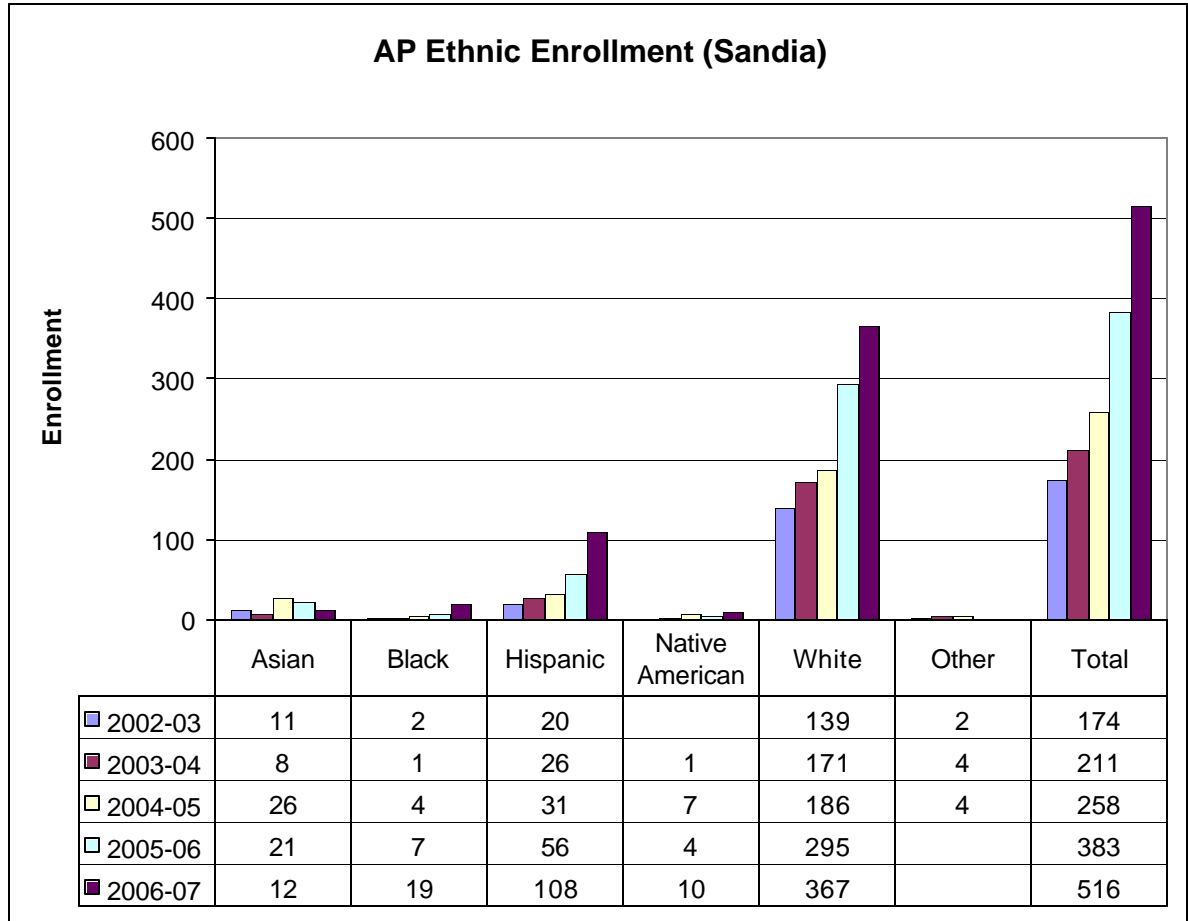


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

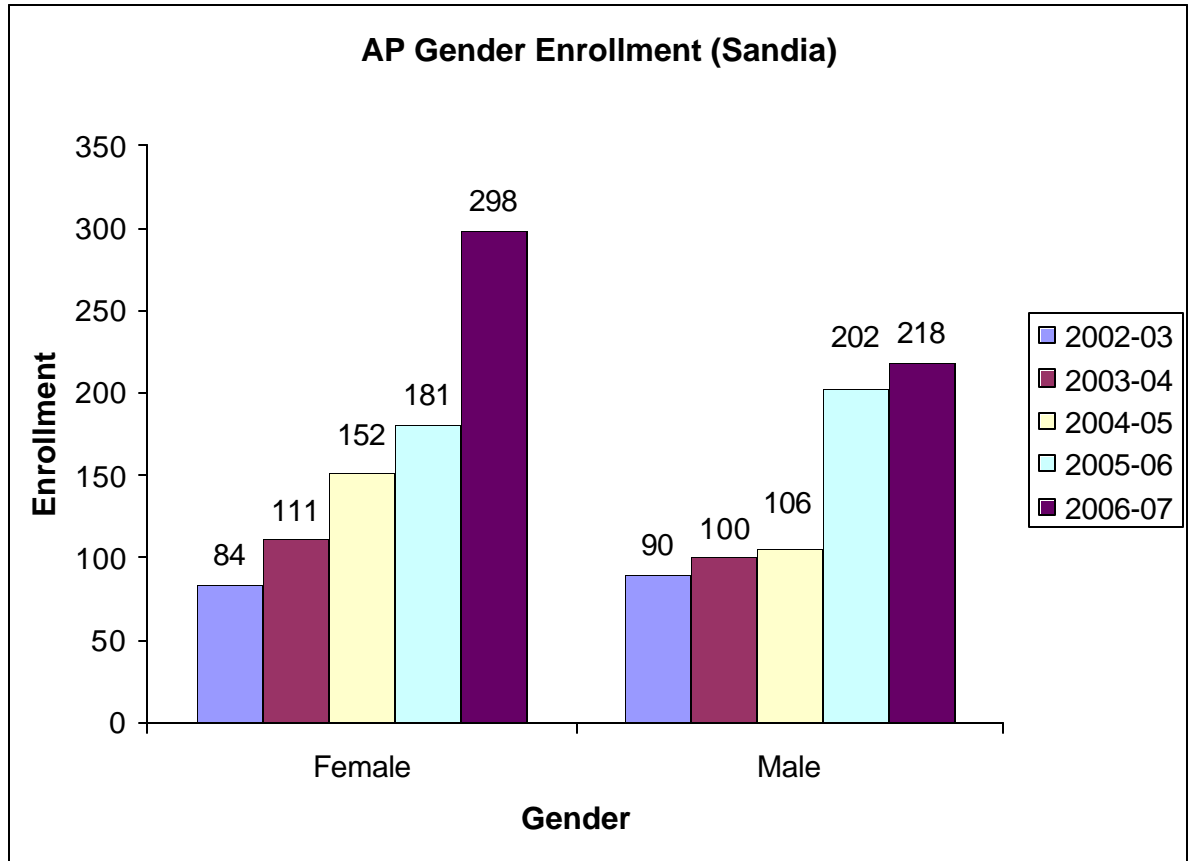

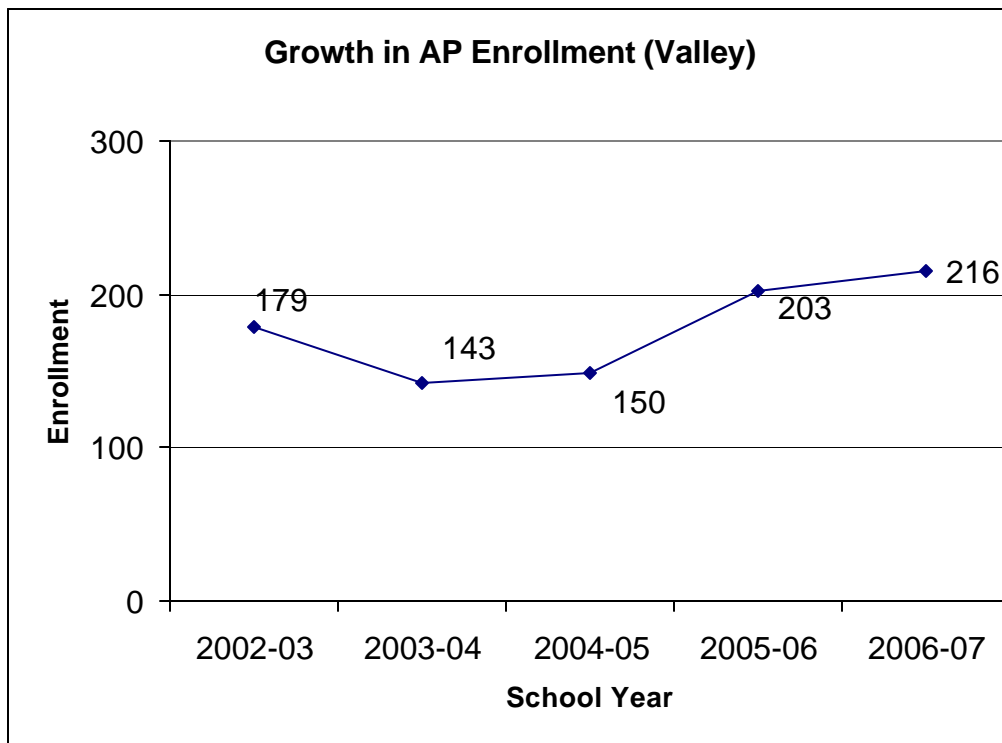


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

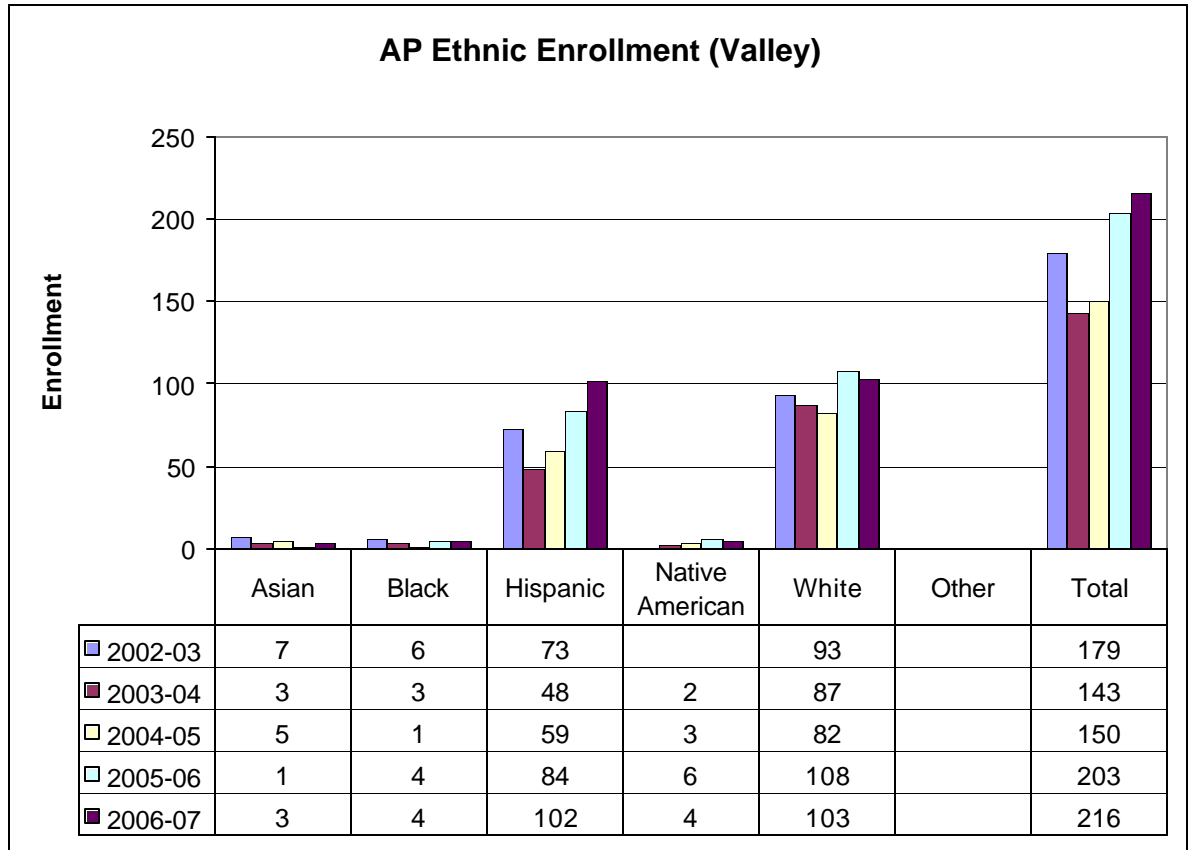


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

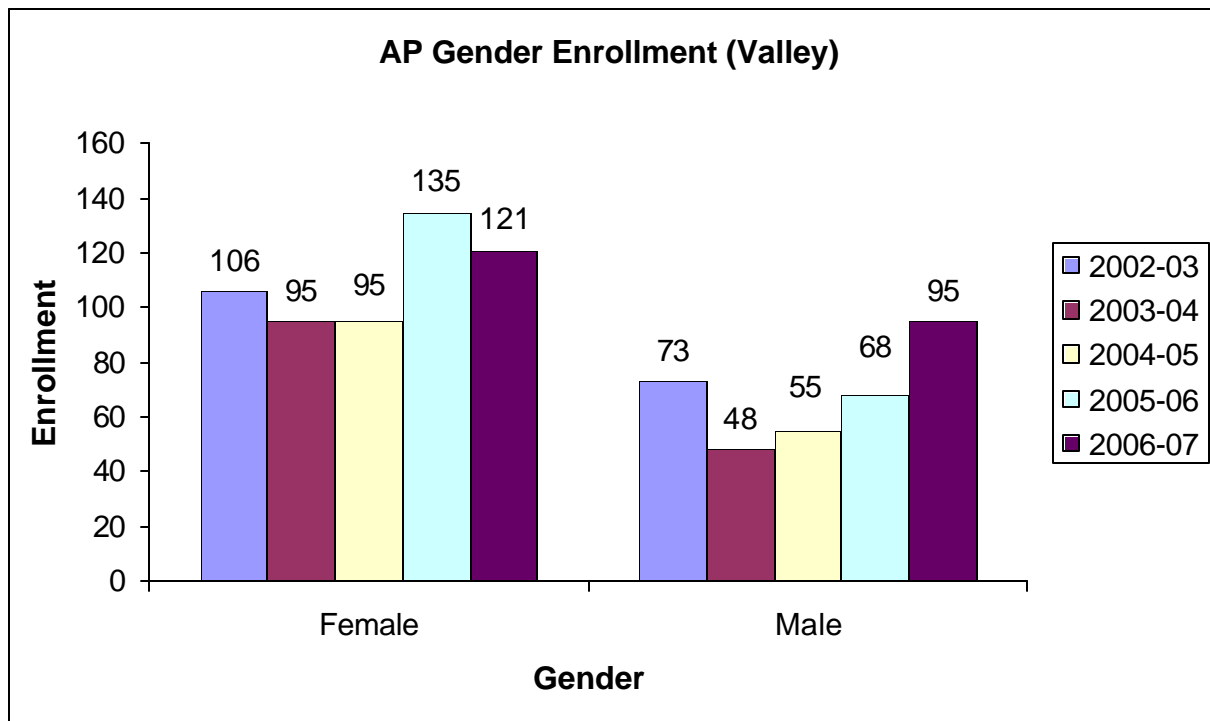

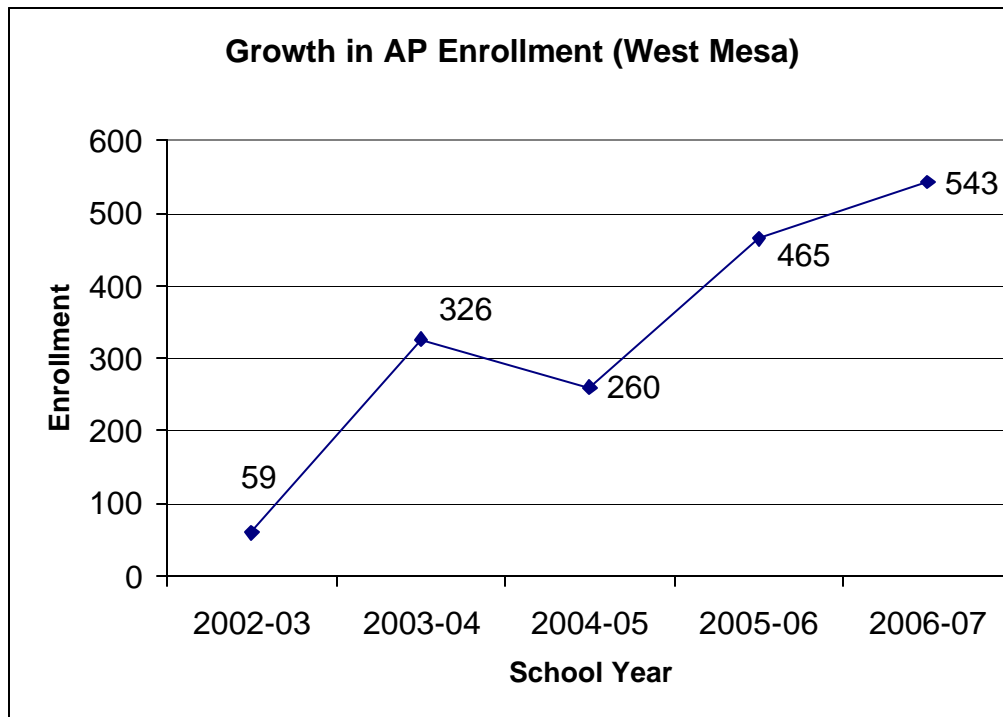


Figure 2 shows the trends in enrollment for each ethnic group over the past five years.

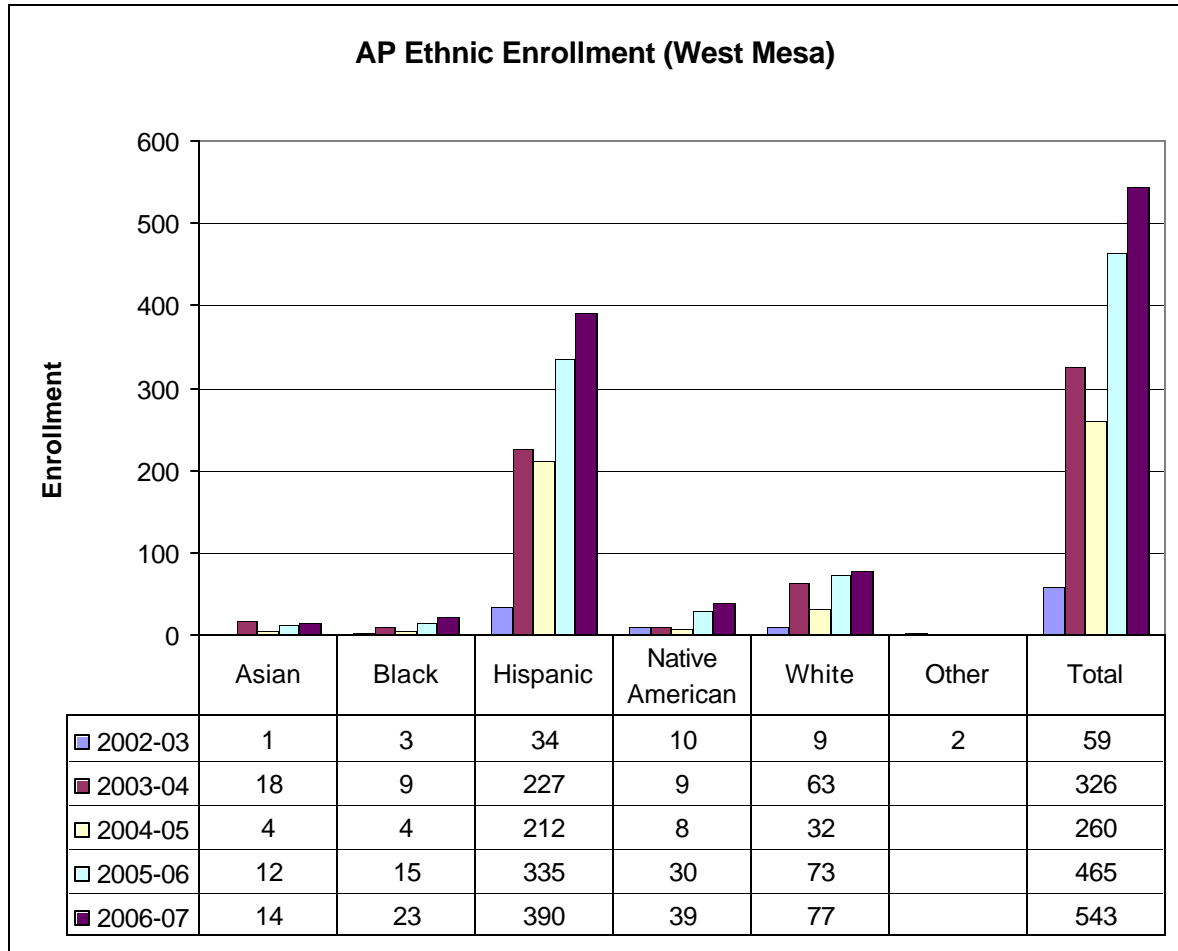


Figure 3 shows the trends in gender enrollment for males and females over the past five years.

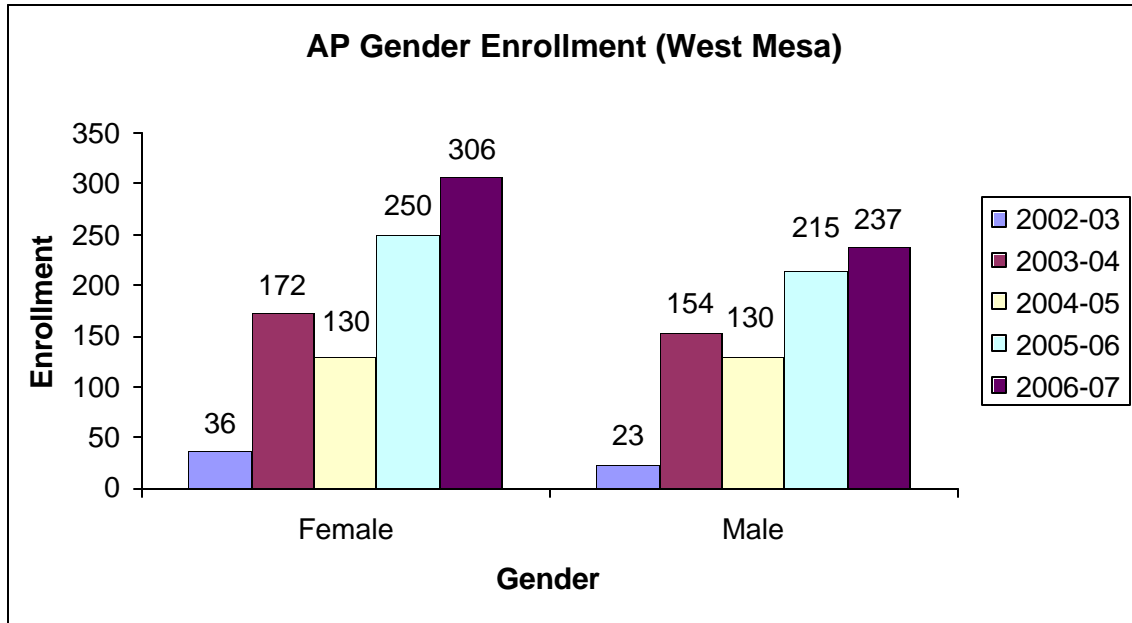
