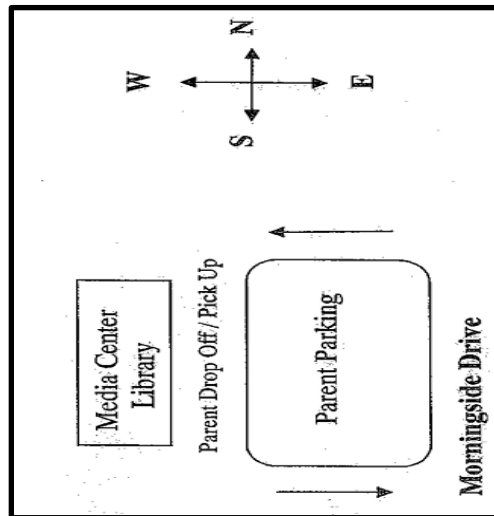
## Breakfast and Lunch
