Summer Programming

Welcome to Summer Learning Adventure, Summer STEAM Experience, and Indian Education at Janet Kahn! Summer programming is a free experience offered to APS students. Summer Programming will provide rich and engaging programs that help students learn, practice, and retain skills throughout the summer.

Pickup and Drop off

Kindergarten and 1st Grade: Students will be dropped off and picked up at the South end of the building (main entrance). This area is for drop-and-go only; no idling or parking is allowed.

2nd-5th Grades: Students will be dropped off and picked up in the drive-through loop off Parsifal (west of campus). This area is also for drop-and-go only; no idling or parking is allowed.

Buses: Will drop off and pick up students in the bus loop on the Southwest corner of campus, on the same side as the main entrance.
