Attendance

- Attendance is very important!!! Families and students must commit to attending each day..

What to Bring

- Students will walk and explore outdoors, play games, and complete other daily tasks. We ask that students dress comfortably, bring a water bottle, and wear comfortable walking shoes. If possible, a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, snacks, and a backpack are also helpful. Teachers may send individual information home about what students need for their class.

Breakfast and Lunch

- Breakfast and Lunch will be provided each day, but students are welcome to bring their own lunch.

Behavior Expectations

- SLA/ESY is a fun, safe, and hands-on learning opportunity. It is important that students are engaged and actively participating every day. All SLA/ESY students will follow the APS Student Behavior Handbook.

Parent Drop off and Pick Up

- The student drop off/pick-up area is off the parking lot on the west side (front) of the school.
- Parents may drop off or pick up their child by: parking in the parking lot and escorting the student to and from the car, using designated crossing areas and obeying staff directions.
- Parents may also pull up to the designated curb in front of the school, remaining in the car, and letting the child in and out on the curbside door for drop off and pick up.
- Due to the size of our school and the high volume of cars, it may take some time for cars to make the entire circuit of the parking lot. Please be patient and wait your turn to pick up your child.
- Cars may not park or pick up students in the fire lanes.
- Due to safety concerns, it is essential that parents observe the painted crosswalks and duty staff instructions when walking to parked cars.
- It is equally important to use only the west parking lot area (front of school) for vehicle pick-ups. There is no supervision at the base of the hill on Richmond Hills and it is not safe for children.
