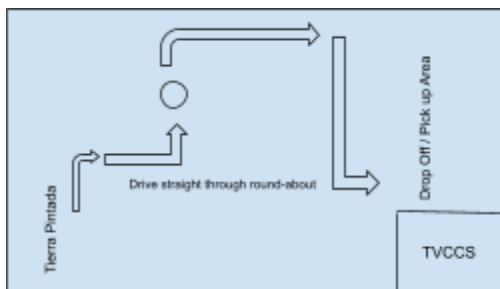
## 🔥 Breakfast and Lunch
