RE: Title I Extended Day Academic Programs Request for Information (RFI)

Title I is pleased to announce that funding for Extended Day Academic Programs (EDAP) is available for school year 2016-2017. Please complete the attached Request for Information and return it to Title I by noon March 15, 2016. The proposal application is also on the Title I website (<http://www.aps.edu/title-i/extended-day-academic-programs>).

**The following guidelines apply for the use of the funding:**

1. Activities must support academic enrichment in the areas of Language Arts, Fine Arts, Mathematics, or Science before or after regular school hours.
2. EDAP requires alignment to Common Core State Standards for all activities.
3. Programs should be designed to strengthen core academics and help provide quality educational support, high quality curriculum, and can include applied learning (Duncan, March 2011).
4. At-risk students should be given priority consideration for participation in activities.
5. Funds may only be used for Extended Day Academic Programs.
6. Only **current APS employees** who are **licensed teachers or EA's** may work for Title I EDAP.
7. Licensed teachers may teach students. Licensed EA's may **only** assist the teachers.
8. EDAP funds can be used to provide small group tutoring (Teacher:Student Ratios as low as 1:3).
9. EDAP does not support homework clubs.
10. The total grant award can not exceed \$8,000 unless the school size is over 1,000 students or a compelling case is made for additional transportation funding.
